5 AN ORDINANCE

6 ESTABLISHING THE LONG RANGE PLANNING SUBCOMMITTEE OF THE
7 PLANNING COMMISSION.

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:

10 Section 1. [NEW MATERIAL.] A new Section 14-2.3(F) SFCC 1987 is
11 ordained to read:

12 (F) Long Range Planning Subcommittee

13 (1) There is established a subcommittee of the Planning Commission called
14 the Long Range Planning Subcommittee for the purpose of making
15 recommendations to the Planning Commission regarding legislative
16 matters including, but not limited to:

- 17 (a) Adoption of the General Plan;
18 (b) Amendments to the General Plan;
19 (c) Chapter 14 amendments for which the Planning Commission has
20 authority to review and make recommendations on; and
21 (d) Long-range policy recommendations as set forth in §14-
22 2.3(C)(7).

23 (2) Three members of the Planning Commission shall be elected by majority
24 vote of the Planning Commission to serve on the Long Range Planning
25 Subcommittee. In addition, the Mayor with the advice and consent of the

1 City Council shall appoint two members to the Long Range Planning
2 Commission who are not members of the Planning Commission. The
3 Long Range Planning Subcommittee shall meet at least once a month. A
4 quorum shall consist of three members.

- 5 (3) City staff shall place the tentative agenda in a local daily newspaper and
6 shall post the tentative agenda in City Hall at least five calendar days
7 prior to the scheduled meeting.



10 (H) Ad Hoc Subcommittees


- 11 (1) Pursuant to NMSA 3-19-1, the mayor, subject to the advice and consent
12 of the Governing Body, may appoint ad hoc subcommittees to gather
13 information and make recommendations to the Planning Commission, as
14 the Planning Commission deems appropriate. The ad hoc subcommittee
15 shall be comprised of volunteer citizens, City staff, and/or commission
16 members.
- 17 (2) The chairman of the Planning Commission may appoint ad hoc
18 subcommittees of the Planning Commission to assist the Commission in
19 accomplishing their powers and duties.
- 20 (3) Meetings of the ad hoc subcommittees shall be open public meetings in
21 accordance with the New Mexico Open Meetings Act, Sections 10-15-1
22 through 10-15-4 NMSA 1978.
