Ord. #2006-34 and codified as Chapter 24, Exhibit A, SFCC 1987) is amended to include the 15 16 following definition: 12-1-42.1 [NEW MATERIAL] OFF-HIGHWAY MOTOR VEHICLE "Off-Highway 17 Motor Vehicle" means a motor vehicle designed by the manufacturer for operation exclusively 18 19 off the highway or road and includes: "all-terrain vehicle", which means a motor vehicle fifty inches or less in width, 20 21 having an unladen dry weight of one thousand pounds or less, traveling on three or more lowpressure tires and having a seat designed to be straddled by the operator and handlebar-type 22

steering control; or

1	(2) "off-highway motorcycle", which means a motor vemele traveling on not mor		
2	than two tires and having a seat designed to be straddled by the operator and that has handlebe		
3	type steering control.		
4	Section 2. Section 12-7-9 of the City of Santa Fe Uniform Traffic Code (being		
5	Ord. #2006-34 and codified as Chapter 24, Exhibit A, SFCC 1987) is amended to read:		
6	12-7-9 OFF-HIGHWAY MOTOR VEHICLES. Off-highway vehicle use is prohibited with		
7.	the municipal boundaries of the city of Santa Fe unless such use is permitted on a designated off-		
8	highway motor vehicle course, track or trail or on private property with the permission of the		
9	property owner.		
10	12-7-9.1 OFF-HIGHWAY MOTOR VEHICLESREGISTRATION; PLATE		
11	REQUIREMENT.		
12	A. No person shall operate a motor vehicle which is to be operated or used		
13	exclusively on designated off-highway vehicle courses, tracks or trails of this municipality unle		
14	the motor vehicle has been registered in accordance with the New Mexico Off-Highway Motor		
15	Vehicle Act and the regulations of the division adopted pursuant thereto.		
16	B. Upon receipt of the registration certificate, the owner of an off-highway motor		
17	vehicle shall affix the registration plate on the motor vehicle as prescribed by the regulations		
18	adopted by the motor vehicle division. (66-3-1003 NMSA 1978)		
19	Section 3. Section 12-7-9.6 of the City of Santa Fe Uniform Traffic Code		
20	(being Ord. #2006-34 and codified as Chapter 24, Exhibit A, SFCC 1987) is amended to		
21	read:		
22	12-7-9.6 ENFORCEMENT OF OFF-HIGHWAY MOTOR VEHICLE		
23	REGULATIONS. Every city police officer displaying his badge of office, has the authority to		
24	enforce the provisions of Sections 12-7-9 through 12-7-9.5 of this ordinance and may require the		
-25	operator of any off-highway motor vehicle to produce the certificate of registration and the		

1	personal identification of the operator, and may issue citations for violations of the provisions of		
2	Sections 12-7-9 through 12-7-9.5 of this ordinance. (66-3-1015 NMSA 1978)
