- (2) Individual Storage Areas within a Completely Enclosed Building
  - (a) The plan for operation of the storage area shall be compatible with

1				other permitted uses existing in the vicinity.
2			(b)	The storage area shall not unreasonably interfere with permitted uses
3				because of noise, vibrations, smoke, dust, odor, heat, glare, traffic
4	;			congestion, or any similar nuisance.
5			(c)	No individual storage unit shall exceed 200 square feet.
6			(d)	No individual storage unit shall be directly accessible from the
7				outside of the building.
8			(e)	Outdoor storage shall be prohibited on the site if located within a C-2
9				district or the BCD.

13			(a)	A wall and/or fencing plan shall be submitted for staff review and
14				approval prior to issuance of a building permit. Fences or walls shall
15				provide a visual buffer or screen and be constructed of opaque
16				materials.
17			(b)	A landscape plan meeting all the requirements of §14-8.4 shall be
18				submitted to City staff for approval prior to issuance of a building
19				permit.
20			(c)	The architecture shall be compatible with the zoning district as
21				approved by City staff. One residential unit excluding mobile,
22				modular, and trailer homes is allowed as part of the storage unit
23				development but this unit shall be architecturally compatible with the
24				storage units. No portion of the storage units or the residential unit
25				shall exceed one story in height.
