- No match requirement, projects are fully funded by the Department of Homeland Security.
- Grant Award is received quarterly on a reimbursement basis.
- All funds must be expended by September 30, 2010.
- Total City of Santa Fe award is \$321,350.00.
- The three projects are as follows:
 - 1. EOD K-9 Training: \$500.00
 - 2. Hazmat Detection Upgrades: \$128, 250.00
 - 3. Fire and Police Training and Overtime Costs: \$192,600.00
