5 AN ORDINANCE

6 AMENDING SECTION 23-1.4 SFCC 1987 REGARDING OBSTRUCTION PERMIT FEES;
7 AMENDING SECTION 23-2.10 SFCC 1987 REGARDING STREET CUT PERMIT FEES
8 AND RESTORATION PENALTIES; AND AMENDING SECTION 23-3-10 SFCC 1987
9 REGARDING CURB CUT FEES.

11 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:

12 Section 1. Section 23-1.4 SFCC 1987 (being Code 1953, § 24-4 – 24-7) is amended to
13 read:

14 23-1.4 Obstruction of Streets.

15 A. *Permit Required; Fee.* Except as otherwise provided, any person desiring to place
16 any obstruction on any public street, alley or way in the city shall make application to the public
17 works department for a permit to do so. Such permit shall be granted on compliance with terms as
18 may be imposed by a city engineer and on the payment of a fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per
19 permit.

20 B. *Warning Lights Required.* Except as otherwise provided, warning lights shall be
21 placed and maintained from sundown to sunup of every day at both ends of every obstruction on any
22 street of the city and at intervals of not more than fifty feet (50') along such obstruction.

23 C. Removal.

24 (1) Any obstruction on any street or alley or in that half of the street adjoining
25 any store, shop, building or premises in violation of paragraphs A. or B. above, shall

1 immediately be removed by the owner or occupant of the premises.

2 (2) It is the duty of any police officer or other authorized city employees finding
3 an obstruction in any street or alley, to notify and require the owner, occupant or person in
4 charge, to remove the obstruction immediately.

5 (3) It is unlawful for any person to refuse or neglect to comply with such order
6 and the city shall immediately remove the obstruction at the expense of the owner or
7 occupant.

8 (4) No person shall hinder, interfere with, or prevent the city from performing
9 any of the duties conferred in this paragraph.

10 **Section 2. Section 23-2.10 SFCC 1987 (being Ord. #1988-2, §11 as amended) is**
11 **amended to read:**

12 **23-2.10 Street Cut Permit Fees, Restoration Penalties; Exemptions.**

13 A. Effective July 1, 2011, a street cut permit fee of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) shall
14 be charged for each street cut permit issued. A separate permit shall be required for each street cut as
15 defined in subsection 22-2.3 SFCC 1987. A single repair project may consist of multiple street cuts.

16 B. Restoration penalties provided for in this section shall be twenty dollars (\$20.00) per
17 square foot of resurfaced area.

18 C. After acceptance or approval by the city of the work completed under the permit, a
19 property owner residing on the property for which the work was completed may apply to the streets
20 division for reimbursement of the fee provided that all dwelling units on the property are occupied by
21 a household earning less than eighty percent (80%) of the area median income as certified by a
22 nonprofit affordable housing organization, under contract with the city, or otherwise qualified
23 organization.
