5	AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
6	ESTABLISHING A NIGHT TIME OUTDOOR CONSTRUCTION MORATORIUM IN
7	INDUSTRIAL ZONED AREAS.
8	
9	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:
10	Section 1. Legislative Findings. The Governing Body finds:
11	A. Santa Fe residents need sleep in order to maintain health;
12	B. The overwhelming majority of Santa Fe residents are asleep between the hours of
13	9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. ("night time sleep");
14	C. Section 10-2.4 SFCC 1987 currently prohibits construction noise in residential
15	and commercial zoned areas between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.;
16	D. However, many Santa Fe residents live in neighborhoods that are located near
17	enough to industrial zoned areas that construction noise in those areas still disturbs their night
18	time sleep;
19	E. Present methods of regulating outdoor construction in industrial zoned areas have
20	been ineffective;
21	F. A bill amending Section 10-2.4 SFCC to prohibit construction noise in all areas
22	of the city between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. the following day has been introduced
23	and will be considered by the Governing Body within four months;
24	G. The lack of sleep is an imminent threat to the health, safety and welfare of Santa
25	Fe residents and is a disturbance of the peace; and

H. The ongoing outdoor construction activity requires the Governing Body to take
immediate, emergency action in the adoption of this Ordinance.

3 Section 2. Prohibition. Outdoor construction in industrial zoned areas is 4 prohibited between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. the following day. 5 Section 3. Effective Date. This emergency moratorium is in effect immediately 6 upon adoption by the Governing Body and shall remain in effect until four months from the date 7 of adoption of this ordinance or the adoption of an ordinance amending Section 10-2.4 SFCC 8 1987 regarding this issue whichever occurs first. 9 Section 4. Penalty for Violations. A violation of this Ordinance by any person, 10 business, or other entity shall be subject to the general penalty provisions of the Article 1-3 SFCC 11 1987. Every five minutes that a violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.
