training coordinated between school and workforce so that their educational experiences have

2	WHEREAS, both the green industry and media arts industry have been identified as
3	target areas for workforce development activity by the State of New Mexico, the Santa Fe Public
4	Schools and the College of Santa Fe.
5	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
6	CITY OF SANTA FE that:
7	1. The Governing Body supports workforce development activities in the
8	community specifically, but not limited to, those outlined in the Tino Griego Talent Pool
9	Business Plan targeting the media arts and green industries.
10	2. Staff is directed to find a location which will effectively serve residents in the
11	southwest sector of Santa Fe with workforce development activities.
12	3. Staff is directed to develop a plan for the use of the funds allocated for
13	film/media arts workforce training at Tino Griego.
