ORDINANCE NO. 2013-32

AN ORDINANCE

**RELATING TO THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL ON CITY PROPERTY;
AMENDING SUBSECTION 23-6.2 SFCC 1987 TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE AND
CONSUMPTION OF BEER ONLY IN THE AREAS DESIGNATED FOR CONCESSIONS
AND SEATING AT FORT MARCY BALLPARK IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE AND
LOCAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:

Section 1. Subsection 23-6.2 SFCC 1987 (being Ord. #2012-20) is amended to

Read:

23-6.2 Permitted Locations for the Sale and Consumption of Alcohol on City Property.

The sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages is permitted at the following locations on city property:

A. The Santa Fe community convention center and adjacent outdoor spaces under the center's control;

B. That area of the Santa Fe municipal airport main terminal building and adjacent areas operated as a restaurant; and

C. The Marty Sanchez Links de Santa Fe (golf course).

D. The area of the Fort Marcy Ballpark designated for concessions and seating shall be used for the sale and consumption of only beer and only at professional baseball games.

(1) A special dispenser permit shall be used to dispense alcohol. The alcohol

1 dispenser shall comply with all state and local laws and regulations for dispensing alcohol
2 pursuant to the special dispenser permit.

3 (a) Persons desiring to consume beer shall be required to wear a
4 wristband that restricts consumption to a maximum of three (3) twelve (12) ounce
5 beers during the course of a professional baseball game.

6 (i) The wristband shall be nontransferable and shall be issued to
7 verify age and to indicate the number of alcoholic beverages purchased.

8 (ii) The purchase of alcoholic beverages shall be limited to one
9 (1) purchase per person at one (1) time.

10 (iii) Twelve (12) ounce beverage containers shall be used for
11 beer.

12 (iv) Alcoholic beverage containers shall be distinguishable from
13 nonalcoholic beverage containers.

14 (b) The sale of beer shall terminate at the end of sixth inning of the
15 professional baseball game.

16 (c) In addition to alcoholic beverages, food and non-alcoholic beverage
17 drinks shall be sold. Water shall be provided at no cost.

18 (d) A manager of the alcohol vendor shall be present at all times in the
19 concession area. A photograph of the manager and his or her name shall be posted at
20 the point of sale of alcoholic beverages. At all times, the manager shall wear a
21 nametag that identifies him or her as the manager.

22 (e) Alcohol servers shall not drink alcohol during baseball games.

23 (f) The vendor shall place signs in the concession area and outside the
24 concession area that indicate the illegality of selling, serving and providing alcohol to
25 minors and intoxicated persons.

1 (2) Any professional baseball league games subject to this section, shall not take
2 precedence over the scheduling of local youth baseball leagues using Fort Marcy Ballpark.

3 E. Buildings owned by another party located on land owned by the city.


4 F. On land or buildings owned by the city for which the city has entered into a lease
5 with another party for six (6) months or more except for the Railyard Park, Plaza and Alameda (as
6 defined in the Deed of Conservation Easement dated October 1, 2004) where alcohol is prohibited.

7 G. In or on railroad cars located on railroad tracks except as prohibited by state or
8 federal law.

9 All other applicable approvals required by state or city laws and regulations shall be obtained
10 prior to the sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages on the property described in this subsection
11 23-6.2.


12 **Section 2. Review.** The provisions of this Ordinance shall be reviewed one year from
