6	AMENDING SECTION 23-4.2 SFCC 1987 REGARDING SOLICITATION ON PUBLIC
7	PROPERTY; CREATING A NEW ARTICLE 20-2 SFCC 1987 REGULATING
8	PANHANDLING ON PUBLIC PROPERTY; CREATING A NEW ARTICLE 20-3 SFCC
9	1987 REGULATING PANHANDLING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY.

11	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:
12	Section 1. Section 23-4.2 SFCC 1987 (being Ord. #1981-39, § 2 as amended) is
13	amended to read:
14	23-4.2 Solicitation on Public Property. The practice by itinerant vendors or solicitors
15	of going onto public property for the purpose of selling goods, wares and merchandise or for the
16	purpose of disposing of the same is prohibited except as otherwise provided by law or authorized
17	by the governing body. Each act of solicitation prohibited by this section shall constitute a public
18	nuisance and a separate violation of this Code. Each violation shall be punishable as provided in
19	Article 1-3 SFCC 1987.
20	Editor's Note: For restrictions on panhandling see Articles 20-2 and 20-3 SFCC
21	1987.
22	Section 2. A new Article 20-2 SFCC 1987 is ordained to read:
23	20-2 [NEW MATERIAL] PANHANDLING ON PUBLIC PROPERTY.
24	Section 3. A new Section 20-2.1 SFCC 1987 is ordained to read:
25	20-2.1 [NEW MATERIAL] Purpose. The purpose of this Ordinance is to establish

1	regulations for panhandling in order to promote the safety and convenience of the city's citizens; to
2	protect the panhandler's right to free speech; and to promote harmony among panhandlers, local
3	businesses, residents and visitors within the city.
4	Section 4. A new Section 20-2.2 SFCC 1987 is ordained to read:
5	20-2.2 [NEW MATERIAL] Definitions. As used in this article:
6	Panhandler means a person who engages in the act of panhandling.
7	Panhandling means:
8	A. Any solicitation made in person upon public property in the city in which
9	a person requests an immediate donation of money or other gratuity from another person
10	and includes, without limitation, seeking donations by vocal appeal; or
11	B. In exchange for a donation, the person being solicited receives an item of
12	little or no monetary value under circumstances where a reasonable person would
13	understand that the transaction is in substance a donation.
14	C. Panhandling shall not include:
15	(1) The act of passively standing or sitting, with a sign or other
16	indication that a donation is being sought without any vocal request, other than in
17	response to an inquiry by another person; or
18	(2) A street performance, as regulated in Article 23-8 SFCC 1987.
19	Section 5. A new Section 20-2.3 SFCC 1987 is ordained to read:
20	20-2.3 [NEW MATERIAL] Regulations. Panhandlers may engage in an act of
21	panhandling on public property in the city provided that the panhandler complies with the
22	following regulations.
23	A. Panhandling is prohibited on any day after sunset or before sunrise within the
24	Business-Capitol District, as shown on the official zoning map of the city of Santa Fe.
25	B. Panhandling is prohibited involving any operator or occupant of a motor vehicle

1	that is in traffic	on or e	entering any street, street intersection, alley or other public passageway in
2	any manner tha	ıt obstrı	acts the operation of any vehicle by any motorist.
3	C.	Panha	ndling is prohibited when either the panhandler or the person being
4	solicited is loca	ated at a	any of the following locations:
5		(1)	At a bus stop;
6		(2)	In any public transportation vehicle or public transportation facility;
7		(3)	In or on any private vehicle or conveyance;
8		(4)	In a sidewalk cafe;
9		(5)	Within twenty (20) feet in any direction from an automatic teller
10	machin	ne or en	trance to a bank;
11		(6)	Within the median of a street; or
12		(7)	On school property.
13	D.	Panha	ndling in an aggressive manner is prohibited, including any of the
14	following actio	ns:	
15		(1)	Touching the solicited person without the solicited person's consent;
16		(2)	Panhandling a person while such person is standing in line and waiting to
17	be adm	itted to	a commercial establishment;
18		(3)	Blocking the path of a person being solicited or the entrance to any
19	buildin	g or ve	hicle;
20		(4)	Following behind, ahead or alongside a person who walks away from the
21	panhan	ıdler aft	er being solicited;
22		(5)	Using profane or abusive language, either during the solicitation or
23	followi	ing a re	fusal to make a donation, or making any statement, gesture, or other
24	commu	ınicatio	n which would cause a reasonable person to be fearful or feel compelled;
25	or		

1	(6) Panhandling in a group of two (2) or more persons.
2	E. Panhandling with a sign exceeding four square feet is prohibited.
3	F. Panhandlers shall not block, or cause the blocking of, any sidewalk, passageway,
4	street, or entrance to a building.
5	G. Panhandling at one location longer than two (2) hours is prohibited and the
6	panhandler shall not return to that same location for two (2) hours.
7	Section 6. A new Section 20-2.4 SFCC 1987 is ordained to read:
8	20-2.4 [NEW MATERIAL] Other Compliance. The conduct and behavior of all
9	panhandlers shall be in compliance with the Santa Fe City Code 1987.
10	Section 7. A new Section 20-2.5 SFCC 1987 is ordained to read:
11	20-2.5 [NEW MATERIAL] Penalties; Enforcement.
12	A. Each act of panhandling prohibited by this section shall constitute a public
13	nuisance and a separate violation of this Code. Each violation shall be punishable as provided in
14	Article 1-3 SFCC 1987.
15	B. It shall be the duty of the police department to enforce the provisions of Article
16	20-2 SFCC 1987.
17	C. Upon the first violation of the provisions of this article, the police may issue a
18	written warning to the person violating this article.
19	D. Upon a second violation by the same person, the police may issue a citation.
20	E. Upon a third and subsequent violation the violator may be subject to arrest.
21	Section 8. A new Section 20-2.6 SFCC 1987 is ordained to read:
22	20-2.6 [NEW MATERIAL] Review. Article 20-2 SFCC 1987 shall be reviewed by
23	the governing body one year from the date of adoption.
24	Section 9. A new Article 20-3 SFCC 1987 is ordained to read:
25	20.2 INEXVIMATEDIAL LOANHANDLING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY

1	Section 10. A new Section 20-3.1 SFCC 1987 is ordained to read:
2	20-3.1 [NEW MATERIAL] Panhandling Prohibited on Private Property.
3	Panhandling on private property is prohibited unless formal written permission is granted from
4	the property owner to the person panhandling. Any violation of this section is punishable as set
5	forth in Article 1-3 SFCC 1987.
