E. Action Items

<u>Case #AR-24-12</u>. Approval of monitoring plan to excavate for an electrical line totaling approximately 1,780′. The project is located along Griffin Street between Paseo de Peralta and Johnson Street, within the Historic Downtown Archaeological review District. This request is made by Robert Dello-Russo, Office of Archaeological Studies, for the Public Service Company of New Mexico.

John Murphy, Staff Liaison

Mr. Murphy did not add to the written staff report presented to the review committee. Mr. Murphy reiterated that roughly between Paseo de Peralta and Johnson Street is a floating piece.

Stephen Lentz representing Dr. Dello-Russo from Archaeological Studies Mr. Lentz said that Dr. Dello-Russo's proposal included in the packet is thorough. Mr. Lentz looked at the background and Dr. Dello-Russo correctly states the excavations. This is pretty standard, we have been doing PNM monitoring for a while. What they are doing is a utility upgrade based on an unfortunate black out that we had a few years ago so these utilities are needed. They are being closely watched. The contractor for PNM is extremely conscientious; we have a monitor on site right now and we intend to continue. These phases as they accrue sequentially, seem to hop around as needed and as far as we can tell they will rotate over to Phase 8 as they are done with the pointed out utility nest behind Kaune's alley.

Mr. Pierce: One question on the plan verification; is the line replacing an existing line? Does that mean the current line is buried or is it an overhead?

Mr. Lentz: It is buried. They are replacing conduits; PNM then comes along and strings the utilities through there.

Mr. Pierce: Good luck, this is close to 1051.

Mr. Ivey: It looks like a good plan, the planning is well planned. I have one question; LA144329 Historic and Pre-Historic (Reserved), I don't know what that notation is.

Mr. Murphy: That means work still in progress.

Mr. Ivey: So that number is assigned to a site and on-going. Thank you.

Mr. Eck: Nothing further to offer.

Mr. Ivey moved to approve <u>Case #AR-24-12</u> - Approval of monitoring plan to excavate for an electrical line totaling approximately 1,780'. The project is located along Griffin Street between Paseo de Peralta and Johnson Street, within the Historic Downtown Archaeological review District, second by Mr. Pierce, motion carried by unanimous voice vote.
