| 19 | have been raised through crowd-funding efforts organized by Mr. Justin Greene; and |

| 21 | process for naming the facility "Max and Friends Dog Park" in accordance with Resolution 2010-19. |

The dog park would be designed that the total expenditures would not exceed \$73,500 for FY18-19. These expenditures would consist of \$66,311 for construction (\$61,311 donated funds + \$5,000 (max.) city funds) plus an estimated \$5,000 for annual cleaning and maintenance of the dog park. If additional donations are received they would be used to decrease or eliminate the \$5,000 in construction funds from the city.
