11	PERMITTING BANNERS TO BE LOCATED ALONG SAN FRANCISCO STREET, OLD		
12	SANTA FE TRAIL, AND CATHEDRAL PLACE TO COMMEMORATE THE 100 ^T		
13	ANNIVERSARY OF THE HISTORIC LA FONDA ON THE PLAZA.		
14			
15	WHEREAS, Santa Fe City Code Section 14-8.10 allows for the installation of banners		
16	erected by the City of Santa Fe ("City") or its designee if permitted by the Governing Body via		
17	Resolution; and		
18	WHEREAS, the Resolution regarding installation of banners must specify dates o		
19	display, location, number, design approval process, installation, maintenance, and cost allocation		
20	and		
21	WHEREAS, the building that houses La Fonda on the Plaza ("La Fonda") can trace its		
22	roots back 400 years, a history that includes a reputation for hospitality for trappers, soldiers, gold		
23	seekers, gamblers, and politicians; and		
24	WHEREAS, the original hotel was built in 1922 by architect Isaac Hamilton Rapp with		
25	Rapp, Rapp, and Hendrickson; and		

1	WHEREAS, architects Mary Elizabeth Jane Colter and John Gaw Meem had major
2	influence on the structure that houses the hotel today, which includes hand carved beams, stained
3	glass skylights, a 25-foot cathedral ceiling, and a bell tower on the southwestern corner of the
4	property; and
5	WHEREAS, the Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe railway acquired the hotel in 1925 and
6	leased the property to the Fred Harvey Company, which turned La Fonda into a renowned "Harvey
7	House", noted for high standards and fine dining; and
8	WHEREAS, La Fonda is a member of the Historic Hotels of America, a program of the
9	National Trust for Historic Preservation recognizing and celebrating the finest historic hotels; and
10	WHEREAS, the owners of La Fonda and the City wish to commemorate and celebrate the
11	historic milestone of La Fonda's 100th anniversary with a public display of banners on three streets
12	bordering the hotel; and
13	WHEREAS, La Fonda is the oldest hotel in the oldest capital city in the United States; and
14	WHEREAS, located on the southeast corner of the Plaza, La Fonda has been witness to
15	much tumult and spectacle of the settling of the West; and
16	WHEREAS, even today, La Fonda offers a vantage point to the ever-unfolding history of
17	La Villa Real de San Francisco de Assis de Santa Fe; and
18	WHEREAS, La Fonda is considered significant to the Downtown and Eastside Historic
19	District and also resides within the Santa Fe Historic District which is a National Register District.
20	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
21	CITY OF SANTA FE that the banners described below are approved:
22	Dates: January 1, 2022 through January 4, 2023.
23	Location: Three banners on San Francisco Street
24	Four banners on Old Santa Fe Trail
25	Two banners on Cathedral Place

1	Number:	Nine total banners	
2	Design Approval Process:	The design of the banners has been approved by the	
3		Historic Design Review Board as conforming to existing	
4		City Code regarding signs in Historic Districts pursuant	
5		to SFCC 1987, Section 14-8.10(H)(11).	
6	Installation:	The owners of La Fonda shall utilize qualified vendors to	
7		install the banners subject to approvals by the Public	
8		Works Department as specified in the following section.	
9	Maintenance:	The owners of La Fonda shall be responsible for	
10		maintenance of the banners. The City reserves the right to	
11		order La Fonda on the Plaza to remove any banners the	
12		City deem in disrepair prior to their scheduled removal	
13		date.	
14	Cost Allocation:	The owners of La Fonda hall be responsible for all costs	
15		associated with the banner program including production	
16		of the banners, installation, maintenance, and removal.	
17	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that as a condition of approval, the owners of La Fonda		
18	provide the following to the City:		
19	1. Approval from the Public Works Department to install banners on the light poles;		
20	2. Permit for Obstruction of Streets issued by the Public Works Department;		
21	3. A surety to the City in a form acceptable to the City Attorney in the event that the		
22	banners are not removed;		
23	4. Certificates of Insurance	ce evidencing the insurance required. La Fonda on the Plaza	
24	and/or the contractors hired to install, maintain, or repair the banners, shall maintain the following		
25	insurance policies:		

1	a. Commercial General Liability for bodily injury and property damage with
2	limits of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 in the aggregate. The
3	policy shall be endorsed to name the City of Santa Fe, its officials, employees, and agents
4	as additional insured.
5	b. Workers' Compensation insurance as required by the State of New Mexico
6	and Employer's Liability with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 per accident or disease.
7	The Workers' Compensation policy shall be endorsed with a waiver of subrogation in favor
8	of the City of Santa Fe, its officials, employees, and agents.
9	5. A release and assumption of liability from the vendor in a form acceptable to the
10	City Attorney.

Approved Scope of Work: Staff is granting administrative approval for the La Fonda banner design for 9 banners/locations with the condition that the city seal be added in order for staff to recommend approval to the governing body.

Prior to the Governing Body's consideration of a resolution for the La Fonda Centennial banners, the Historic Districts Review Board was being given an informational presentation of the banner proposal on 10/26/2021. In evaluating suitability and harmony, staff has considered the general purpose of the historic district regulations (14-5.2(A)(1)) and the purpose of the historic sign regulations (14-8.10(H)(1)) and will be providing administrative approval as a recommendation to the governing body for their consideration per (14-8.10(A)(1)).

The banners are proposed to hang from banner posts which will be located on light posts owned by the City. Additionally, the banners will hang over the public right-of-way. In order for the banners to be permitted by the City the applicant must seek a resolution to 14-8.10 that allows the banners for specific dates, location, number, design approval, installation, and maintenance (following City of Santa Fe New Mexico Ordinance No. 2009-29) to allow the legal obstruction of a public way per SFCC section 23-1.4. Nine banners are proposed; five will be located on the west side of La Fonda along Old Santa Fe Trail and four are proposed on the north side of La Fonda along San Francisco Street. The event will span the duration of the centennial year and are proposed to be in place from January 1, 2022 to January 4, 2023.







