

PUBLIC MEETING

Bishops Lodge Road Reconstruction Project Paseo de Peralta north to the Santa Fe City Limits


WHAT: The City of Santa Fe is in the early stages of the design for the reconstruction of Bishop's Lodge Road between Paseo De Peralta and the city limits just north of the Pedregal Place intersection. The purpose of this reconstruction is to address speeding, vehicular and pedestrian

safety concerns, and any existing drainage issues. This project is being designed by Wilson & Company – an engineering firm contracted by the City Public Works Department.

The City of Santa Fe requires an Early Neighborhood Notification (ENN) meeting be conducted for the city capital improvement projects. It is intended to provide opportunity for the community to review, comment, and provide feedback capital on the city's infrastructure projects before plans become firm too to respond meaningfully to community's concerns.

WHEN: Thursday, September 29, 2022 5:30pm to 7:30pm

WHERE: City of Santa Fe Convention Center at 201 W. Marcy Street in the O'Keefe, Milagro, Kearny rooms (rooms are combined to provide the appropriate area for public gathering).
