

NOTICE UNDER THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT

In accordance with the requirements of Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA), the Santa Fe Trails Transit Division will not discriminate against qualified individuals with disabilities on the basis of disability in its services, programs or activities.

Employment: Santa Fe Trails Transit does not discriminate on the basis of disability in its hiring or employment practices and complies with all regulations promulgated by the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission under Title I of the ADA.

Modifications to Policies and Procedures: Santa Fe Trails Transit will make all reasonable modifications to policies and programs to ensure that people with disabilities have an equal opportunity to enjoy all of its programs, services and activities.

The ADA does not require that Santa Fe Trails take any action that would fundamentally alter the nature of its programs or services, or impose any undue financial or administrative burden.
