10 **A RESOLUTION**

11 **AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL DURING THE**
12 **ANNUAL BURNING OF ZOZOBRA COMMUNITY EVENT PRODUCED BY THE**
13 **KIWANIS CLUB OF SANTA FE, INC., A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION AT FORT**
14 **MARCY, DURING THE FRIDAY OF LABOR DAY FOR THE YEARS 2022-2025,**
15 **PURSUANT TO SFCC 1987 SUBSECTION 23-6.2.**

17 **WHEREAS**, the Governing Body adopted Ordinance No. 2021-14 on August 11, 2021,
18 revising the process for approving the consumption of alcohol on city property, which is codified
19 as SFCC 1987Section 23-6.2; and

20 **WHEREAS**, for locations not specifically mentioned in Section 23-6.2(A), the ordinance
21 requires, at least thirty (30) days in advance of the event, the Governing Body to approve a
22 resolution permitting the sale and consumption of alcohol that specifies the event, date, hours,
23 location, number of expected attendees, type of alcohol to be served, permits, and insurance; and

24 **WHEREAS**, Section 23-6.2(B) limits alcohol sales and consumption at Fort Marcy
25 ballpark to beer and wine; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the Annual Burning of Zozobra is produced by Kiwanis Club of Santa Fe,
2 Inc. (the “Kiwanis Club”), a local non-profit organization, which is celebrating Zozobra’s 98th
3 Burning in 2022, its 99th Burning in 2023, its 100th Burning in 2024, and its 101st Burning in 2025,
4 with each burning scheduled to occur on the Friday of Labor Day weekend of each year; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the Annual Burning of Zozobra is an internationally known and unique
6 cultural event created by famed Santa Fe artist Will Shuster in 1924 and staged annually by the
7 Kiwanis Club since 1964; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the Annual Burning of Zozobra remains a popular local cultural event as well
9 as a strong tourism and economic development generator for the City of Santa Fe; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Kiwanis Club seeks authorization from the Governing Body to sell beer and
11 wine at Fort Marcy Ball Park on the Friday of Labor Day weekend for the years 2022-2025, for a
12 total of four annual events, in accordance with City of Santa Fe and State of New Mexico
13 requirements.

14 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
15 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the sale and consumption of alcohol on City property for the following
16 event is hereby approved.

21 Location:	Fort Marcy Park
