24	WHEREAS, the Annual Burning of Zozobra is produced by Kiwanis Club of Santa Fe,		
25	Inc. (the "Kiwanis Club"), a local non-profit org	ganization, which is celebrating Zozobra's 98th

1	Burning in 2022, its 99 th Burning in 2023, its 100 th Burning in 2024, and its 101 st Burning in 2025,		
2	with each burning scheduled to occur on the Friday of Labor Day weekend of each year; and		
3	WHEREAS, the Annual Burning of Zozobra is an internationally known and unique		
4	cultural event created by famed Santa Fe artist Will Shuster in 1924 and staged annually by the		
5	Kiwanis Club since 1964; and		
6	WHEREAS, the Annual Burning of Zozobra remains a popular local cultural event as well		
7	as a strong tourism and economic development generator for the City of Santa Fe; and
