A RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL DURING THE ANNUAL BURNING OF ZOZOBRA COMMUNITY EVENT PRODUCED BY THE KIWANIS CLUB OF SANTA FE, INC., A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION AT MAGERS FIELD, DURING THE FRIDAY OF LABOR DAY FOR THE YEARS 2022-2025, PURSUANT TO SFCC 1987 SUBSECTION 23-6.2.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body adopted Ordinance No. 2021-14 on August 11, 2021, revising the process for approving the consumption of alcohol on city property, which is codified as SFCC 1987Section 23-6.2; and

WHEREAS, for locations not specifically mentioned in Section 23-6.2(A), the ordinance requires, at least thirty (30) days in advance of the event, the Governing Body to approve a resolution permitting the sale and consumption of alcohol that specifies the event, date, hours, location, number of expected attendees, type of alcohol to be served, permits, and insurance; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Burning of Zozobra is produced by Kiwanis Club of Santa Fe, Inc. (the “Kiwanis Club”), a local non-profit organization, which is celebrating Zozobra’s 98th

1 Burning in 2022, its 99th Burning in 2023, its 100th Burning in 2024, and its 101st Burning in 2025,
2 with each burning scheduled to occur on the Friday of Labor Day weekend of each year; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the Annual Burning of Zozobra is an internationally known and unique
4 cultural event created by famed Santa Fe artist Will Shuster in 1924 and staged annually by the
5 Kiwanis Club since 1964; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Annual Burning of Zozobra remains a popular local cultural event as well
7 as a strong tourism and economic development generator for the City of Santa Fe; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Kiwanis Club seeks authorization from the Governing Body to sell beer and
9 wine at Magers Field on the Friday of Labor Day weekend for the years 2022-2025, for a total of
10 four annual events, in accordance with City of Santa Fe and State of New Mexico requirements.

11 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
12 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the sale and consumption of alcohol on City property for the following
13 event is hereby approved.

- 14 Event: Annual Burning of Zozobra
- 15 Dates: September 2, 2022; September 1, 2023; August
16 30, 2024; and August 29, 2025.
- 17 Hours: 5:30 pm to 9:30 pm
- 18 Location: Magers Field
- 19 Number of expected attendees: Up to 2,000 attendees
- 20 Permit(s): Special Dispenser Permit
- 21 Required insurance: Liquor liability insurance in the amount of
22 \$1,000,000.00
- 23 Other terms: The event shall adhere to all regulations required
24 in SFCC 1987 Section 23-6.3.
