A RESOLUTION

ADOPTING THE 2024-2028 INFRASTRUCTURE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PLAN (“ICIP”).

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe, New Mexico, a New Mexico municipal corporation, recognizes that the financing of public capital projects is a major concern in New Mexico and nationally; and

WHEREAS, in times of scarce resources, it is necessary to find new financing mechanisms and maximize the use of existing resources; and

WHEREAS, systematic capital improvements planning is an effective tool for communities to define their development needs, establish priorities, and pursue concrete actions and strategies to achieve necessary project development; and

WHEREAS, the City’s plan for capital projects contributes to local and regional project identification and selection in short and long-range capital planning efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Finance and Administration requires the City to adopt a Resolution identifying a five-year, Infrastructure Capital Improvement Plan, as specified in its ICIP


1 Guidelines – Submissions Specifications, for the City of Santa Fe to receive capital outlay funding
2 from the State of New Mexico.

3 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY**
4 **OF SANTA FE** that

5 1. The City of Santa Fe hereby adopts the attached 2024-2028 Infrastructure Capital
6 Improvements Plan; and

7 2. The Plan is intended to be a working document and is the first of many steps toward
8 improving rational, long-range capital planning and budgeting for New Mexico’s infrastructure.
