10 **A RESOLUTION**

11 **SUPPORTING THE SANTA FE PUBLIC SCHOOLS (“SFPS”) IN ADOPTING A**
12 **COMMUNITY SCHOOLS MODEL AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO**
13 **SUPPORT THE CITY’S CONTINUED COLLABORATION AND PARTICIPATION**
14 **WITH THE SFPS’S COMMUNITY SCHOOLS STEERING COMMITTEE.**

16 **WHEREAS**, the Community Schools Act’s, NMSA 1978, Sections 22-32-1 et al., purpose
17 is, “to provide a strategy to organize the resources of a community to ensure student success while
18 addressing the needs, including cultural and linguistic needs, of the whole student from early
19 childhood programs and voluntary public pre-kindergarten through high school graduation; to
20 partner federal, state and local and tribal governments with community-based organizations to
21 improve the coordination, delivery, effectiveness and efficiency of services provided to students
22 and families; and to coordinate resources, in order to align and leverage community resources and
23 integrate funding streams.”; and

24 **WHEREAS**, Santa Fe Public Schools (SFPS) passed resolution 2020-2021-4, Community
25 Schools: A Collaborative Focus, in support of and adoption of the community schools model [for

1 all SFPS schools]; and

2 **WHEREAS**, on August 31, 2022, the Governing Body adopted Resolution No. 2022-49
3 that established the Governing Body’s support for SFPS’s grant application to build out the
4 community schools model throughout the school district; and

5 **WHEREAS**, as addressed in the SFPS resolution, the basis for community schools is to
6 provide a pathway for students, parents, and the community to foster student success; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the City has a vested interest in seeing its youngest constituents succeed and
8 thrive in school and their community; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the City’s Youth and Family Services Division has had an active role as part
10 of the steering committee for community schools since the fall 2021 and would like to formalize
11 that role.

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
13 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the City Manager shall support the City’s collaboration and work with
14 the Santa Fe Public Schools Community Schools Steering Committee to identify needed support
15 and assistance for the implementation and success of community schools.


