**A RESOLUTION**

**EXTENDING THE TERM OF THE COMMUNITY HEALTH AND SAFETY TASK FORCE UNTIL JUNE 30, 2023, TO ALLOW THE TASK FORCE TO COMPLETE ITS DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES.**

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 2020-29, adopted July 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020, created a Community Health and Safety (“CHS”) Task Force to explore and examine ways in which the City’s community health and safety services can work together as complementary parts of an overall strategy for the benefit of all residents of Santa Fe; and

**WHEREAS**, the CHS Task Force consists of eleven members appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the Governing Body; and

**WHEREAS**, the slow execution of a contract with the University of New Mexico to survey, provide interviews, and create a report reflecting a broad cross-section of the Santa Fe community, has delayed the work of the Task Force; and

**WHEREAS**, the survey will allow the community to contribute advice and offer experiences and ideas that will help improve the quality and consistency of community health and

1 safety; and

2           **WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 2020-29 specified that the Task Force should conclude its  
3 work no more than six months from the date the members are appointed, a time frame that has  
4 lapsed; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 2020-29 stated that the Governing Body may further extend  
6 the work of the Task Force if such extension is needed; and

7           **WHEREAS**, the Governing Body previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-73 that  
8 extended the duration of the CHS Task Force through the end of calendar year 2022; and

9           **WHEREAS**, the CHS Task Force requests an additional extension to fully complete its  
10 work and to provide a report to the Governing Body pursuant to the Duties and Responsibilities  
11 set forth in Resolution No. 2020-29.

12           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**  
13 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the term of the Community Health and Safety Task Force is extended  
14 until June 30, 2023, to complete the Duties and Responsibilities specified in Resolution No.  
15 2020-29.


