3	C. A copy of the codes set forth in paragraph A and this chapter shall be kept on file
4	in the office of building inspections and shall be available for public inspection at all reasonable
5	times.
6	D. Should the state of New Mexico's construction industries division amend the
7	codes adopted in paragraph A above, the City will apply the State's amended codes, unless
8	otherwise amended by this chapter.
9	Section 2. Section 7-1.9 of SFCC 1987 (being Ord. #2016-8, § 3) is amended to
10	read:
11	7-1.9 - Amendment to Section 1602 of the Uniform Plumbing Code; Non-Potable
12	Rainwater Catchment Systems.
13	A. Section 1602.1 of the Uniform Plumbing Code shall be deleted and the following
14	substituted:
15	1602.1 General. The installation, construction, alteration, and repair of rainwater
16	catchments systems intended to supply uses such as water closets, urinals, clothes washers, trap
17	primers for floor drains and floor sinks, irrigation, industrial processes, water features, cooling
18	tower makeup, and other uses shall be approved by the Authority Having Jurisdiction. Additional
19	design information can be found in ARCSA/ASPE 63.
