12	12-3.9	Restrictions on the sale and use of fireworks.	
13	А.	The sale and use of the following fireworks are prohibited during extreme or severe	
14	drought conditi	ons, based on current drought indices published by the national weather service:	
15	(1)	Aerial devices, such as	
16		a) Ariel shell kit-reloadable tubes;	
17		b) Aerial spinners;	
18		c) Helicopters;	
19		d) Mines;	
20		e) Missile-type rockets;	
21		f) Multiple tube devices;	
22		g) Roman candles;	
23		h) Shells; and	
24		i) Stick-type rockets.	
25	(2)	Ground audible devices, such as

1	a) Chasers; and			
2	b) Firecrackers.			
3	B. The use of all fireworks is prohibited within any lands covered wholly or in part			
4	by timber, brush, or native grass.			
5	C. The above restrictions do not apply to public displays of fireworks in strict			
6	conformance with the requirements and conditions set forth in subsection 12-3.3 SFCC 1987 and			
7	as approved by the city of Santa Fe fire chief.			
8	D. The governing body may implement additional restrictions during severe or			
9	greater drought conditions pursuant to Section 60-2C-8.1 NMSA 1978.			
10	E. Penalties.			
11	(1) Any individual, firm, partnership, or other entity found in violation of			
12	this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by			
13	imprisonment for up to ninety (90) days or a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars			
14	(\$500.00), or both.			
15	(2) Each and every occasion on which this section is violated shall be			
16	considered a separate offense.
