**A RESOLUTION**

**APPROVING THE CITY OF SANTA FE’S PARTICIPATION IN A TRANSPORTATION PROJECT FUND PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE AGUA FRIA/SOUTH MEADOWS INTERSECTION.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Santa Fe (“City”) and the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) have entered into a grant agreement under the Transportation Project Fund (“TPF”) for Improvements to the Agua Fria/South Meadows Intersection; and

**WHEREAS**, the total cost of the project is anticipated to be \$735,000, to be funded in proportional share by the parties hereto as follows:

1. NMDOT’s share is ninety-five percent (95%) or \$698,250.00; and
2. The City’s proportional matching share is five percent (5%) or \$36,750.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the City agrees that it will pay all costs which exceed the total amount of \$735,000.00, to the extent permitted under the law.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE** that the Governing Body hereby approves a cooperative agreement for

1 Project Control number LP50046 with NMDOT through the TPF for year 2024 improvements to  
2 the Agua Fria Street/South Meadows Road intersection, including the construction of five-foot  
3 wide bicycle lanes, six-foot wide sidewalks, turn lanes, driveways, drainage, and traffic signals  
4 within control of the City.

5 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this project is a priority for the City.


6 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the cooperative agreement terminates on June 30,  
7 2026, and the City incorporates all agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties  
8 concerning the subject matter and that all such agreements, covenants, and understandings have  
9 been merged into the written agreement.
