11	AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF APPLICATIONS TO THE FEDERAL TRANSIT
12	ADMINISTRATION, AN OPERATING ADMINISTRATION OF THE UNITED STATES
13	DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, FOR FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION
14	ASSISTANCE AS AUTHORIZED BY 49 U.S.C. 53, TITLE 23, UNITED STATES CODE,
15	OR OTHER FEDERAL STATUTES ADMINISTERED BY THE FEDERAL TRANSIT
16	ADMINISTRATION.
17	WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation has delegated the authority to
18	award federal financial assistance for transportation projects and operations to the Federal Transit
19	Administration ("FTA"); and
20	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe ("City") is a recipient of FTA funding, and it is a
21	prerequisite of the FTA that the City demonstrate legal capacity to carry out projects included in
22	federal assistance awards; and
23	WHEREAS, to demonstrate legal capacity, FTA requires funding recipients to authorize local
24	agents to request, receive, and spend FTA funds to administer FTA-assisted projects; and
25	WHEREAS, the City Attorney affirms the legal authority of the City's authorized official to

make and comply with annual certifications and assurances on behalf of the City as required by the FTA for federal grant or cooperative agreements.

WHEREAS, a grant or cooperative agreement for federal financial assistance will impose obligations upon the City, and may require the City to provide a local share of the project cost; and WHEREAS, the New Mexico Department of Transportation, which, as defined by 49 U.S.C. 5307 (a)(2), is the FTA's designated authority to appropriate funding, has granted the City authority to apply for an allocation of funding under the Section 5307, "Urbanized Area Formula Program"; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to 49 U.S.C. 5323(n), the FTA is required to publish its annual certifications and assurances each year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that this Resolution is the City of Santa Fe's ("City's") documentation and certification of eligibility under the law to request, receive, and spend FTA funds in order to administer FTA assisted projects; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the City's Transit Director of Administration or Public Works Director are authorized to execute and file applications on behalf of the City with the FTA for federal assistance authorized by 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53, title 23, United States Code, or other federal statutes authorizing a project administered by the FTA.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Public Works Director is authorized to execute and file on behalf of the City the annual certifications and assurances, grant and cooperative agreements, and other documents the FTA requires before the FTA awards a federal assistance grant or cooperative agreement.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** if matching funds are required for an FTA award, the City Manager shall work with the Transit Director of Administration and/or Public Works

Director to ensure the City has budgeted the matching funds before executing agreements for the
