21	artisans from throughout the world; and
22	WHEREAS, IFAM is a significant event benefiting the City of Santa Fe's tourism
23	industry; and
24	WHEREAS, IFAM wishes to partner with Tumbleroot Brewery and Distillery, promoting
25	a local business to the community.

13		\$2,000,000, per occurrence and in the aggregate, with the
14		City of Santa Fe, its officials, directors, and employees,
15		and agents as additional insureds on a primary and
16		noncontributory basis. The International Folk Art Market
17		shall provide the City with Certificates of Insurance and
18		applicable endorsements evidencing such coverage.
