**A RESOLUTION**

**AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF BEER AND WINE DURING  
PORTIONS OF THE INTERNATIONAL FOLK ART MARKET ON JULY 10 AND 12,  
2025, PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION 23-6.2(C) SFCC 1987.**

**WHEREAS**, SFCC 1987, Section 23-6.2, governs the consumption of alcohol on city  
property; and

**WHEREAS**, for serving alcohol at City properties not specifically mentioned in SFCC  
1987, Section 23-6.2(A), the ordinance requires the Governing Body to approve a resolution that  
specifies the event, date, hours, location, number of expected attendees, type of alcohol to be  
served, permits, and insurance, at least thirty (30) days prior to the event; and

**WHEREAS**, the International Folk Art Market (“IFAM”) is an annual event featuring  
artisans from throughout the world; and


**WHEREAS**, IFAM is a significant event benefiting the City of Santa Fe’s tourism  
industry; and

**WHEREAS**, IFAM wishes to partner with Tumbleroot Brewery and Distillery, promoting  
a local business to the community.

1           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**  
2 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that alcohol service during IFAM is hereby approved according to the  
3 following parameters:

4           Event:                               International Folk Art Market events  
5           Dates:                               July 10 and July 12, 2025  
6           Hours:                               6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.  
7           Location:                           The Railyard Park  
8           Number of expected attendees: Up to 2,500 attendees are expected in the Railyard Park at  
9   any given time during the event.  
10          Type of alcohol to be served: Beer and wine.  
11          Required Permits:               Public Celebration Permit.  
12          Required Insurance:           Liquor Liability insurance with limits not less than  
13   \$2,000,000, per occurrence and in the aggregate, with the  
14   City of Santa Fe, its officials, directors, and employees,  
15   and agents as additional insureds on a primary and  
16   noncontributory basis. The International Folk Art Market  
17   shall provide the City with Certificates of Insurance and  
18   applicable endorsements evidencing such coverage.
