11	ADOPTING THE CITY OF SANTA FE'S REGIONAL ANNUAL TRANSIT SERVICE
12	PLAN FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026; ACCEPTING THE NORTH CENTRAL REGIONAL
13	TRANSIT DISTRICT'S (NCRTD'S) FISCAL YEAR 2026 PROPOSED FUNDING OF
14	REGIONAL SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF SANTA FE ("CITY") OF
15	\$1,421,890; AND APPROVING SUBMITTING THE CITY'S REGIONAL ANNUAL
16	TRANSIT SERVICE PLAN FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026 TO THE NCRTD'S BOARD OF
17	DIRECTORS FOR APPROVAL.
18	WHEREAS, the Regional Transit Act, NMSA 1978, Section 73-25-4, authorizes a
19	combination of two (2) or more governmental entities to create a regional transit district; and
20	WHEREAS, the City of Espanola, Los Alamos County, Pojoaque Pueblo, Rio Arriba
21	County, San Ildefonso Pueblo, San Juan Pueblo, Santa Clara Pueblo, the City of Santa Fe ("City"),
22	Santa Fe County, and Tesuque Pueblo entered an agreement to create the North Central Regional
23	Transit District ("NCRTD") in 2004; and
24	WHEREAS, Resolution 2008-55 withdrew the City from the NCRTD; and
25	WHEREAS, NCRTD's Resolution 2008-14 stated that "in order to create a truly effective

and efficient regional system that cooperatively and equitably serves north central New Mexico, the NCRTD believes that the City of Santa Fe should be a member of the District" and updated terms of the membership; and

WHEREAS, through Resolution 2008-87, the City joined the NCRTD under the updated terms of NCRTD's Resolution 2008-14 and, soon thereafter, expanded City-delivered transit services to provide connected transportation to and from the Rail Runner, through funding made available by the NCRTD; and

WHEREAS, the City provides regional service routes as described in the Annual Transit Service Plan detailed below, and NCRTD's Resolution 2011-10 requires that, prior to committing Regional Transit Gross Receipts Transit taxes, the routes must be included in the City's "annual service plan and adopted by the NCRTD Board as well"; and

WHEREAS, the Transit Division of the City's Public Works Department has implemented the following regional transit services for adoption as the City's Regional Fiscal Year 2026 Annual Transit Service Plan:

- Santa Fe Trails Route 22, serving the New Mexico 599 Rail Runner station as well as Rancho Viejo and Santa Fe Community College;
- 2. Santa Fe Trails Route 2 and 4, serving inbound and outbound Rail Runner trains at South Capitol Station;
- 3. Santa Fe Pick-Up Historic District Shuttle operations, providing shuttle service to and from the Rail Runner station at the Railyard and downtown destinations;
  - 4. Special Event Services to:
    - a. accommodate visitors and residents alike:
    - b. meet increased demand for Rail Runner transfers;
    - c. Folk Art Market, Spanish Market, and Indian Market weekends; and annual community celebrations of Zozobra and the Canyon Road Farolito

2	WHEREAS, the Public Works Department understands that NCRTD has identified
3	funding in the amount of \$1,421,890 in its Fiscal Year 2026 budget to keep the aforementioned
4	regional services, operated by the City, funded and operating through Fiscal Year 2026.
5	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
6	CITY OF SANTA FE that it adopts the City's Regional Fiscal Year 2026 Annual Transit Service
7	Plan described above.
8	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City will accept NCRTD's reimbursement to the
9	City for regional transit services it provides, up to \$1,421,890.
10	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a representative from the Public Works Department
11	shall forward a copy of this Resolution to NCRTD's Board of Directors.
