**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-4**

**A RESOLUTION**

**AMENDING THE LAS SOLERAS MASTER PLAN FOR TRACTS 19, 20, 21, 23, 24 AND 26, COMPRISED OF APPROXIMATELY 41.44 ACRES; CHANGING THE LAND USE DESIGNATIONS FROM MIXED USE, BIP (BUSINESS INDUSTRIAL PARK), AND C-1 (GENERAL OFFICE) TO C-2 (GENERAL COMMERCIAL) AND TO REDUCE THE WIDTH OF THE UTILITY AND TRAIL CORRIDOR (LA RAMBLA TRAIL) FROM 90 TO 45 FEET ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF BECKNER ROAD (CASE NO. 2024-7899).**

**WHEREAS**, on February 11, 2009, the Governing Body of the City of Santa Fe (“City”) annexed property known as Las Soleras Subdivision, into the city of Santa Fe; and

**WHEREAS**, on the same day, the Governing Body approved General Plan amendments, rezonings, a lot line adjustment, and a road dedication plat, subject to fifty (50) conditions of approval, known as the Las Soleras Master Plan (“Master Plan”); and

**WHEREAS**, on September 9, 2015, the Governing Body approved amended the Master Plan, to realign roads, reconfigure open and space trails, reduce park land, and reconfigure certain tracts of land; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 24, 2016, the Governing Body approved Case No. 2016-64 and

1 adopted Resolution No. 2016-78, which amended the Master Plan, to establish alternative height and  
2 setback standards for the residential six dwelling units per acre and residential twelve dwelling units  
3 per acre residentially zoned districts for Estancias de Las Soleras and Ross’s Peak developments; and

4       **WHEREAS**, on September 12, 2018, the Governing Body approved Case No. 2018-50 and  
5 adopted Resolution No. 2018-59, which approved Amendment No. 3 to the Master Plan, which changed  
6 the zoning from mixed use to residential, twenty-one dwelling units per acre, for property located  
7 between Governor Miles, Interstate 25 and Cerrillos Road and Richards Avenue, reduced the 90-foot  
8 utility and trail corridor to 45 feet on the North Side of Beckner Road; and

9       **WHEREAS**, on May 31, 2023, the Governing Body approved Case No. 2021-3811 and  
10 adopted Resolution No. 2023-27, which approved Amendment No. 4 to the Las Soleras Master Plan,  
11 which increased the density from six units per acre to ten units per acre for land located at 4601 Rail  
12 Runner Road; and

13       **WHEREAS**, Orion-West, agent for Beckner Road Partnership, LLC (“Applicant”), applied to  
14 amend the Las Soleras Master Plan for approximately 41.44 acres of land, known as Tracts 19, 20, 23,  
15 24 and 26, and identified in Attachment A (the “Property”), from Mixed Use (MU), Business Industrial  
16 Park (BIP), and General Office (C-1) to General Commercial (C-2) and to reduce the width of the  
17 Utility and Trail Corridor (La Rambla Trail) from 90 feet to 45 feet south of Beckner Road (“Proposed  
18 Amendment”); and

19       **WHEREAS**, amending the Master Plan requires an early neighborhood notification (“ENN”) meeting and Applicant held an ENN on November 14, 2023; and

21       **WHEREAS**, SFCC 1987, Section 14-3.9(D)(1) requires the following findings for an  
22 amendment of a master plan:

23       (a) The master plan is consistent with the general plan;

24       (b) The master plan is consistent with the purpose and intent of the zoning districts that apply  
25 to or will apply to the master plan area and with the applicable use regulations and

1 development standards of those districts;

2 (c) Development of the master plan area will contribute to the coordinated and efficient  
3 development of the community; and

4 (d) The existing and proposed infrastructure, such as the streets system, sewer and water lines,  
5 and public facilities, such as fire stations and parks, will be able to accommodate the  
6 impacts of the planned development; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission reviewed evidence related to the Proposed  
8 Amendment, held a public hearing on the Proposed Amendment on September 5, 2024, and  
9 recommended the Governing Body approve the Proposed Amendment; and

10 **WHEREAS**, on January 9, 2025, the Governing Body held a public hearing on the Proposed  
11 Amendment; having reviewed the staff report, the recommendation of the Planning Commission, and  
12 the evidence obtained at the public hearing; and determined that the proposed amendment to the Master  
13 Plan, as recommended by the Planning Commission, meets the approval criteria set forth in Section 14-  
14 3.9(D)(1) of SFCC 1987 as follows:

- 15 • the Proposed Amendment is consistent with the general plan;
- 16 • the Proposed Amendment is consistent with the purpose and intent of the applicable zoning  
17 districts and the applicable use regulations and development standards for those districts;
- 18 • the development with the Proposed Amendment will contribute to the coordinated and  
19 efficient development of the community; and
- 20 • the existing and proposed infrastructure will be able to accommodate the impacts of the  
21 Proposed Amendment.


22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Master Plan for Tracts of land more  
23 particularly described in Attachment A, known as Tracts 19, 20, 21, 23, 24 and 26 of the Las Soleras  
24 Master Plan, are amended to change the land use designations of the Property from Mixed Use,  
25 Business Industrial Park, and General Office to Community Commercial, and the width of the Utility

1 and Trail Corridor (La Rambla Trail) is reduced from 90 feet to 45 feet south of Beckner Road.

2 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the following uses shall be prohibited on the  
3 Property: auto body and automotive services, packaged liquor stores, bars that are not  
4 associated with a restaurant serving food, cannabis production, manufacturing or retail, and  
5 24-hour restaurants.

6 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that except for medical businesses and services,  
7 business hours open to the public on the Property are limited to between the hours of 5 AM  
8 and 11 PM.
