This Addendum forms a part of the Contract Documents and modifies or supplements the Project Specifications or the Drawings as indicated below. All other provisions of the Contract Documents shall remain unchanged. This Addendum is hereby made a part of the Contract Documents to the same extent as those provisions contained in the original documents and all itemized listings thereof. Bidders shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the appropriate space on the Bid Form (page 4-5).

A. Project Specifications

- 1. Contract Documents, Cover Page
 - a. Replace the cover page in its entirety with the attached document.
- 2. Section 2, Instructions to Bidders
 - a. Page 2-2, Paragraph 8, Interpretations: Replace the third sentence with the following: "Questions received less than four (4) days prior to the date for opening bids will not be answered."

NOTE: Due to the upcoming holiday, questions will be accepted until July 7, 2014, 2:00 PM MDT.

- b. Page 2-7, Paragraph 15, Submission of Bids: Replace the second sentence with the following: "The Bid Form **may** be detached from the bound set of Contract Documents."
- 3. Section 4, Bid Form
 - a. Page 4-3, Bid Schedule: In the third column ("Brief Description of Item with Unit Bid Price in Words"), replace "linear foot" with "lump sum."

- 4. Section 13, State of New Mexico Wage Rates Determination
 - a. Page 13-2: Replace this page in its entirety with the attached New Mexico Department of Workforce Solutions Wage Decision #SF-14-0957 A.

NOTE: The Wage Rates Determination was inadvertently omitted from the original publication.

5. Section 01025, Control of Work

a. Page 01046-3, Paragraph 1.09, Water for Construction Purposes: Replace Part A in its entirety with the following: "The Owner receives treated effluent wastewater (reclaimed wastewater) from the City of Santa Fe Wastewater Plant via Marty Sanchez Golf Course. The Owner operates and monitors the use of Class 1B reclaimed wastewater under NMED Discharge permit number DP-1120. Contractor may use reclaimed wastewater for cell construction at no charge if the appropriate usage log(s) are maintained and coordinated with the Owner. If reclaimed wastewater is not available on site for the Contractor, then the Contractor shall be responsible for transporting and purchasing reclaimed wastewater to the cell construction area.

Contractor shall pay the Owner for its use of reclaimed wastewater at fifty percent (50%) of the rate for potable water as set forth in the City of Santa Fe Sanitary Sewer Rate, Fee and Penalty Schedule (Chapter XXV SFCC 1987)."

NOTE: Through 2014, the cost of the reclaimed wastewater is \$3.37 per 1000 gallons.

- 6. Section 01046, Measurement and Payment
 - a. Page 01025-2, Item No. 3 Subgrade Preparation: Replace the first sentence with the following: "Shall include all labor, equipment and incidentals required for clearing and grubbing, excavation, borrow, embankment, **Cell 5B/6B separation berm**, and installation of subgrade over the Cell No. 5B landfill area as shown on the Drawings."
 - b. Page 01025-3, Item No. 9 Leachate Collection System Piping: In the third line, add "riser pipe caps" between "fittings" and "washed gravel material."

 - a. Section 3, Cell 5B to Cell 6B Separation Berm: Add the following: "Note 2. Install minimum 10' liner run-out from toe of Cell 6B berm. This excess liner shall be protected with the plywood"

 - a. Detail A, Leachate Riser: Insert the following: "Note 3. Contractor shall replace all six existing riser pipe caps for Cell 1 through 6. Contractor shall field verify sizes for each cap."

C. Questions/Responses

1. **Question/Comment:** Is the Contractor required to submit the entire book of Contract Documents with his/her bid?

Response: No. The Contractor shall submit two copies of the applicable bid documents (refer to Section 2, Instructions to Bidders, Paragraph 21) with his/her bid. See also the revision to Section 2 above.

2. **Question/Comment:** Is the Contractor required to submit the Non-Collusion Affidavit of Bidder/Subcontractor with his/her bid or is this document to be submitted after award?

Response: The Non-Collusion Affidavit (Section 6, Supplemental Bid Forms) shall be submitted with the bid.

3. **Question/Comment:** Is the Contractor required to submit the Certification of Bidder/Subcontractor Regarding Equal Employment Opportunity with his/her bid or is this document to be submitted after award?

Response: The Certification of Bidder/Subcontractor Regarding Equal Employment Opportunity (Section 6, Supplemental Bid Forms) shall be submitted with the bid.

- 4. **Question/Comment:** Which version of the New Mexico State Highway & Transportation Department Standard Specifications applies to this project? **Response:** The 2014 edition shall apply to this project (refer also to General Note 18 on Sheet G-1, General and Civil Notes, Abbreviations).
- 5. **Question/Comment:** What are the operating hours of the Caja del Rio Landfill? May the Contractor work outside of this schedule?

Response: The Caja del Rio Landfill is open Monday through Saturday, 7AM to 5PM MDT. It is acceptable should the Contractor wish to work outside of this schedule; he/she must coordinate directly with the Owner for an access key.

- 6. **Question/Comment**: Will electricity/power be available to the Contractor. **Response**: No. The Contractor shall supply power as appropriate for construction.
- 7. **Question/Comment:** Is a proctor available on the existing soil stockpile. **Response**: No.
- 8. **Question/Comment:** Is a Professional Engineer's stamp required on the pump design?

Response: Yes. The pump manufacturer shall provide this (refer also to the first note on Detail E, Sheet CD-2, Leachate Collection System Details).

9. **Question/Comment:** What tests are included in the Allowance? **Response:** The purpose of the \$15,000 allowance is to cover the expenses of the field conformance testing, such as the geotechnical tests for the drainage layer, compaction testing for the subgrade, etc. The allowance shall also be used to cover the shipping/handling and laboratory testing fees for the geosynthetic materials, such as destructive tests for the liner. Therefore, the allowance shall be used for ALL field conformance testing.

In addition to the manufacturers' quality control certificates, the Owner many request additional quality for the geosynthetic materials (liner, GCL, etc.). If additional testing is required, the Quality Assurance Technician (QAT) must be present at the time of testing and physically collect the sample to be tested. While requests for this type of testing are infrequent, the Contractor shall be prepared to conduct these tests. Tests of this type are also covered by allowance.

Required geosynthetic material field tests (liner seam tests, liner destructive tests, etc.) shall be performed in accordance with the specifications and is covered by the allowance. In addition, samples that require off-site laboratory analyses, the shipping/handling and laboratory testing fees are covered by the allowance.

PUBLIC WORKS PROJECT REQUIREMENTS

As a participant in a Public Works project valued at more than \$60,000 in the State of New Mexico, the following list addresses many of the responsibilities that are assigned by statute to each project stakeholder.

Contracting Agency

- Ensure that all contractors/prime contractors wishing to bid on a Public Works project when the project is \$60,000 or more are actively registered with the Labor Relations Division, Labor Enforcement Fund (LEF) prior to bidding.
- Provide completed Notice of Award (NOA) and Sub-Contractor list to Labor Relations Division promptly after the project is awarded.
- Provide updates to the Sub-Contractor list to the Labor Relations Division

General Contractor

- Provide to the Contracting Agency within 3 (Three) days of award a complete subcontractor list and Statements of Intent (SOI) to pay Prevailing Wages for each contractor.
- Ensure that all sub-contractors wishing to bid on a Public Works project when their portion is over \$60,000 are actively registered with the Labor Relations Division prior to bidding.
- Submit bi-weekly certified payrolls to the owner/contracting agency.
- Make certain NM Apprenticeship and Training Fund payments are to be paid either to an approved Apprenticeship program or to the Labor Relations Division.
- Confirm the Wage Rate poster, provided by the Labor Relations Division, is displayed at the job site in an easily accessible place.
- Make sure, when a project has been completed, the Affidavits of Wages Paid (AWP) is sent to the Contracting Agency.

Sub-Contractor

- Ensure that all sub-contractors wishing to bid on a Public Works project when their portion is over \$60,000 are actively registered with the Labor Relations Division prior to bidding.
- Submit bi-weekly certified payrolls to the General Contractor(s).
- Make certain NM Apprenticeship and Training Fund payments are to be paid either to an approved Apprenticeship program or to the Labor Relations Division.


