CITY OF SANTA FE AMENDMENT No. 2 TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT ITEM#17-0825

AMENDMENT No. 2 (the "Amendment") to the CITY OF SANTA FE
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT, dated July 26, 2017 (the "Agreement"),
between the City of Santa Fe (the "City") and Wilson and Company (the "Contractor").
The date of this Amendment shall be the date when it is executed by the City and the
Contractor whichever occurs last.

RECITALS

- A. Under the terms of the Agreement, Contractor has agreed to provide engineering services to the City of Santa Fe with regard to the Guadalupe Street Reconstruction Project from Agua Fria North to Paseo de Peralta.
- B. Pursuant to Article 19 of the Agreement, as amended, and for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged by the parties, the City and the Contractor agree as follows:

1. SCOPE OF SERVICES

Article 1 of the AGREEMENT is amended to include additional tasks under Phase II design services, adding right-of-way mapping and right-of-way real estate services, in conjunction with EXHIBIT "A-2" attached hereto and incorporated herein.

2. <u>COMPENSATION.</u>

Article 3, paragraph A of the Agreement is amended to increase the amount of compensation by a total of three hundred three thousand, one hundred ninety-six dollars and thirty-one cents (\$303,196.31), plus applicable gross receipts taxes, so that Article 3,

paragraph A reads in its entirety as follows:

The City shall pay to the Contractor in full payment for services rendered a sum not to exceed seven hundred thousand, two hundred twenty-one dollars and ninety-nine cents (\$700,221.99), plus applicable gross receipts tax in full payment for Phase I [LOCATION STUDY]. Phase II [Preliminary & Final Design], Phase III [Bidding Services]. Compensation for PHASE IV [CONSTRUCTION SERVICES] may be negotiated and added by amendment to this agreement if required. The Unit Rate Schedule, attached as EXHIBIT "B-2" shall be used by the Contractor in the assembly of cost proposals for individual project assignments or tasks for the additional engineering services.

3. AGREEMENT IN FULL FORCE.

Except as specifically provided in this Amendment, the Agreement remains and shall remain in full force and effect, in accordance with its terms.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have executed this Amendment No. 2 to the City of Santa Fe Professional Services Agreement as of the dates set forth below.

Mrs. Anderson,

We have prepared Amendment 2 to incorporate several additional tasks, which are required to secure NMDOT/FHWA concurrence for project letting and construction. The additional tasks incorporated in the Contract Agreement by way of Amendment No. 2 include (1) Guadalupe Street Right-of-way Mapping, and (2) Right-of-way Real Estate Services. A detailed scope of services is provided in the following sections. The labor man-hour estimate provided herewith is not anticipated to change unless the scope is revised or the NMGRT is updated.

Task Description

1. Right-of-Way Mapping

The original scope was to prepare 10 TCP exhibits for the project with no Right-of-Way (ROW) mapping. Based on design we have 19 Takes/CMEs and 22 Temporary Construction Permits, TCPs, (total of 41 affected ROW parcels). This fee is based on the 19 Takes/CMEs and 12 TCPs since the current agreement has 10 TCPs under contract. Included in the fee is Appraisal Staking; however, Monumentation Mapping is not included in the scope as this work falls under *Engineering & Construction Services* during construction. The ROW Maps allow the property to be acquired and the Monumentation Maps are the final product that allows the Takes/CMEs to be monumented to meet the Minimum Standards for Surveying in New Mexico.

a. ROW Mapping

- 1. Verify existing right of way (which is established) with NMDOT Lands Verification Unit.
- Field Survey for 19 Takes/CMEs and 12 (22 total) TCPs. Define the full boundary of the 19 Takes/CMEs and sidelines for 12 (22 total) TCPs.
- 3. Prepare TCP list to be part of submittal with ROW Mapping.
- 4. Prepare ROW Maps which include cover sheet, parcel block sheets and map sheets.
- 5. Submit to NMDOT Lands Verification Unit for review. We have assumed two reviews.

b. Title Reports

- Meet with NMDOT and Title Company for kick off meeting on preparation of 22 Ownership Reports and 19 Full Title Reports (perform 33 year search).
- Utilize title reports and ownership reports to complete parcel block sheets and use survey documents to plot out the properties and show easements.





- 3. During the process of acquisition we will have to update the ownership reports and title reports 2 times to be in compliance with Federal Standards (6 months).
- 4. Updating the Ownership reports and Title Reports twice was not part of the original scope.
- c. Appraisal Staking
 - 1. Stake TCPs and Takes in field for Appraisal purposes.

2. Right-of-way Real Estate Services

Now that the existing ROW determination is complete, we have identified 41 ROW parcels consisting of 19 partial takes and 22 TCPs. According to information provided by Client, it is anticipated that the Project's ROW needs include a total of 41 ROW parcels consisting of 19 partial takes and 22 TCPs. According to preliminary information from Client and Santa Fe County Assessor data, the 41 affected ROW parcels are owned by a total of 32 separate owners/entities (4 individual owners and 28 corporate entities). Pursuant to Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970 as amended (49 CFR Part 24) ("the Uniform Act"), federal funding requires that the project adhere to the NMDOT Right-of-Way Handbook with regard to acquisitions. Tierra Right-of-Way, a third party consultant, has been retained to provide real estate services and a copy of their services is attached hereto as Exhibit "B".
