THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2023 by and between PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF NEW MEXICO, a New Mexico corporation, hereinafter called "PNM" or "Company", and <u>City of Santa Fe Water Division</u>, hereinafter called "Customer." Customer and Company hereby agree as follows:

1. Customer is requesting the Company to provide electric service to the following described property or real estate:

- 2. To provide service to this property will require an extension of the Company's electric system (the "line extension" or "facilities") described as follows:

 Install 8 Pull Boxes 36" X 48" traffic rated (installed by PNM Contractor), Install 9 Pull Boxes 55" X 55" traffic rated (installed by PNM Contractor)' approximately 1600' of 2" PVC Conduit, approximately 2135' of 4" PVC approximately 7680' of 1/0 AL JCN (installed by PNM Contractor), Conduit, approximately 8315' of 3 Phase1/0 AL JCN (installed by PNM Contractor) 1-750 kVA 3 phase transformer, 1-150 kVA three phase transformer and Pad, 71 1/0 JCN splices, 1275', trenching to be done by PNM Contractor with compaction, 1 Bushing Mounted Three Phase CT Metering, and all labor to complete line extension.
- 3. The Customer agrees to pay for the line extension cost as indicated below. The Customer understands the estimated cost and initial credit determinations are final and no additional credits will be given.

- 5. Customer shall (in advance of construction) provide a purchase order to the Company for the total cost payable by Customer under paragraph 3 above, and Customer shall not be required to pay the Company for any costs of construction until such construction has been completed.
- 6. It is understood and agreed that the facilities installed hereunder shall be and remain the property of the Company, and the Company shall, subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, assume full responsibility for future operation and maintenance of said facilities.

- 7. Service furnished hereunder will be in accordance with the Company's Rules and Regulations and pursuant to its rate schedules applicable to the type of service required. The Company's Rules and Regulations and rate schedules are on file with the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission ("NMPRC" or "Commission") and are incorporated herein by reference and made a part of the Agreement.
- 8. Customer shall furnish and/or assist the Company in obtaining all necessary easements and rights of way for construction of the facilities; rights of ingress and egress; and the right of excavation as required for installation, maintenance, repair or replacement of any of the facilities. All easements shall be of public record and, in the case of plats, clearly shown on such plats prior to final recording. Customer agrees to provide grades plus or minus three (3) inches in accordance with the "final grade and drainage plan" of record on all Customer-provided utility easements and locate lot lines as required by the Company. Any relocation due to changes in location of easements, lot lines, or grades will be at the expense of Customer and will be non-refundable.
- 9. This Agreement, including the Electric Line Extension Policy which is made a part hereof, shall at all times be subject to such changes and modifications as shall be ordered from time to time by any legally constituted regulatory body, including the NMPRC, having jurisdiction to require such changes or modifications. Notice shall be given in accordance with the Commission's requirements if and when the Commission is requested to take action which could cause a change in the terms of this Agreement.
- 10. The entire understanding between the parties hereto relating to this Agreement and its Addendum is set forth herein and there are no oral understandings between the parties. No amendments to this Agreement are authorized unless reduced to writing and signed by authorized representatives of each party.

This agreement incorporates the additional terms and conditions PNM and the City of Santa Fe.

INDEMNIFICATION

PNM shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend the CUSTOMER from all losses, damages, claims or judgments, including payments of all attorneys' fees and costs on account of any suit, judgment, execution, claim, action or demand whatsoever arising from PNM's performance under this Agreement as well as the performance of PNM's employees, agents, representatives and subcontractor.

NEW MEXICO TORT CLAIMS ACT

Any liability incurred by the CUSTOMER in connection with this Agreement is subject to the immunities and limitations of the New Mexico Tort Claims Act, Section 41-4-1, et. seq. NMSA 1978, as amended. The CUSTOMER and its "public employees" as defined in the New Mexico Tort Claims Act, do not waive sovereign immunity, do not waive any defense and do not waive any limitation of liability pursuant to law. No provision in this Agreement modifies or waives any provision of the New Mexico Tort Claims Act. Notwithstanding the foregoing, to the extent that losses, claims, damages, or judgments, including attorney's fees and costs on account of any suit, judgment, execution, claim, action, or demand arises out of the acts or omissions of CUSTOMER or any party for whom CUSTOMER is liable, CUSTOMER releases PNM, its affiliates and each of their respective officers, employees, contractors, and consultants from liability.

APPLICABLE LAW; CHOICE OF LAW; VENUE

PNM shall abide by all applicable federal and state laws and regulations, and all ordinances, rules and regulations of the City of Santa Fe. In any action, suit or legal dispute arising from this Agreement, the PNM agrees that the laws of the State of New Mexico shall govern. The parties agree that any action or suit arising from this Agreement shall be commenced in a federal or state court of competent jurisdiction in New Mexico. Any action or suit commenced in the courts of the State of New Mexico shall be brought in the First Judicial District Court in Santa Fe, New Mexico.

APPROPRIATIONS

The terms of this Agreement are contingent upon sufficient appropriations and authorization being made by the CUSTOMER for the performance of this Agreement. If sufficient appropriations and authorization are not made by the CUSTOMER, this Agreement shall terminate upon written notice being given by the CUSTOMER to PNM. The CUSTOMER's decision as to whether sufficient appropriations are available shall be accepted by PNM and shall be final.

RELEASE

PNM, upon acceptance of final payment of the amount due under this Agreement, releases the CUSTOMER, its officers and employees, from all liabilities, claims and obligations whatsoever arising from or under this Agreement. PNM agrees not to purport to bind the CUSTOMER to any obligation not assumed herein by the CUSTOMER unless PNM has express written authority to do so, and then only within the strict limits of that authority.

INSURANCE

PNM shall maintain professional liability insurance throughout the term of this Agreement providing a minimum coverage in the amount required under the New Mexico Tort Claims Act. PNM shall furnish the CUSTOMER with proof of insurance of PNM's compliance with the provisions of this section as a condition prior to performing services under this Agreement.

THIRD PARTY BENEFICIARIES

By entering into this Agreement, the parties do not intend to create any right, title or interest in or for the benefit of any person other than the CUSTOMER and the PNM. No person shall claim any right, title or interest under this Agreement or seek to enforce this Agreement as a third party beneficiary of this Agreement.

SEVERABILITY

In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this Agreement or any application thereof shall be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions contained herein and any other application thereof shall not in any way be affected or impaired thereby.

ITEM AND ISSUE:

Request for approval of contract with Public Service Company of New Mexico (PNM) for a 3-phase electric line extension from Canyon Road Water Treatment Plant to Nichols Dam in the amount of \$614,606.56; Request approval of a BAR/Increase from the Water Enterprise Fund Cash Balance in the amount of \$614,606.56. John Del Mar, jpdelmar@santafenm.gov, 505 955-4231

BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY:

The Water Division requires 3 phase power at Nichols Dam to power a reservoir aeration system. The aeration system will improve reservoir water quality by oxidizing naturally occurring iron and manganese. This aeration and oxidation process will result in an improved water treatment process at the Canyon Road Water Treatment Plant (CRWTP) and improved water quality to customers. Iron and Manganese both contribute to "brown water" complaints, and both currently require additional water treatment chemicals and processes at the CRWTP.

The 3-Phase power will also be used during Nichols Dam Outlet Rehabilitation Project, or other future projects, to power bypass pumping equipment to divert river flow around the reservoir dam.

The Water Division installed 3200 feet of electric conduits along Canyon Road from the existing electric service meter panel at Nichols Dam to the northeast corner of the CRWTP site in conjunction with CRWTP Raw Water Supply Pipeline project which was completed in late 2020. PNM will complete running 700 feet of electric conduit in Canyon Road to the northwest corner of the CRWTP. PNM will install pull boxes and wire for the entire 3900 foot length of the 3 phase electric line extension and install a transformer near Nichols dam crest.

PROCUREMENT METHOD:

The project site is within the PNM service area and PNM is the only available electric utility. This contract is exempt under 13-1-98 – D: Purchases of publicly provided or publicly regulated gas, electricity, water, sewer, telecommunication, cable television and refuse collection services.
