LICENSE AND TRANSFER AGREEMENT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF FIBER OPTIC INFRASTRUCTURE ON CITY PROPERTY

This LICENSE AGREEMENT (<u>License</u>), is made this 17th day of May, 2023 by and between the CITY OF SANTA FE, a municipal corporation (<u>City</u>), and INTERNATIONAL FOLK ART ALLIANCE (IFAA) a New Mexico corporation (<u>Licensee</u>), (collectively, the <u>Parties</u> and each individually a <u>Party</u>).

WITNESSETH:

In consideration of Licensee's promises herein, City hereby gives the Licensee a License, revocable and terminable as hereinafter provided, to enter on, use and occupy the property of the City as provided herein.

1. PREMISES.

The City allows Licensee to use a portion of City-owned real property located within the Santa Fe Railyard Park Parking Lot, which includes an area between the City of Santa Fe Rail Line Corridor that crosses Callejon Road into the Santa Fe Railyard Park Parking Lot and connecting to the Railyard Park Community Building. More specifically, the Licensee may: Connect to the existing Fiber Optic Line running along the South-East boarder of the Rail Line Corridor; may install an underground Fiber Optic Line extension from this location to the Railyard Park Community Room by boring but not trenching; may install the required infrastructure within or onto the Railyard Park Community Room; for the purpose of making the associated data connection available for use by the Licensee or any other entity granted access; subject to the terms and conditions of this License as specified herein and as approved in writing by the City's Facilities Division Director or their designee. The licensed portion of City-owned real property is shown on **Exhibit A** attached hereto and made a part of this License Agreement. The Premises are provided in an "as is" condition.

2. <u>TERM.</u>

This License shall commence on the date of last signature, below, and shall continue until July 31, 2023, (the Term), unless otherwise terminated as provided herein. At the end of the Term, Licensee shall have one (1) "Option Term" of one (1) month. The Option Term is contingent upon compliance with this License and, if desired by Licensee, must be exercised by proper written notice by Licensee to the City at least 15-days prior to the expiration of the Term. Granting of the Option Term shall be at the City's sole discretion.

3. LICENSE FEE.

At the completion of the Term, or at the completion of the Option Term (if exercised by Licensee and consented to by the City), Licensee shall Transfer Ownership of all improvements made by the Licensee on City property, which shall be the "License Agreement Fee" paid to the City.

4. TRANSFER.

Upon completion of construction, inspections, and acceptance of the Fiber Optic Infrastructure, the Licensee shall convey the Fiber Optic Infrastructure (depicted and described in **Exhibit B**) to the City, free and clear of any liens or encumbrances upon the expiration of this License. Licensee shall promptly deliver and transfer to the City any property held by it under this License and shall execute and deliver any further assurance, conveyance, act, or deed necessary for that purpose. The City agrees to grant any requested future use of the Fiber Optic Infrastructure by the Licensee, during a similar IFAM annual sale event at the Railyard, free of any charge from the City, during the event.

5. CONDITIONS OF USE.

Licensee's use of the Premises shall at all times be in compliance with the provisions of this License including the following conditions of use:

- A. <u>Permitted Use.</u> Use of the Premises is restricted to the installation and development of a fiber optic infrastructure.
- B. <u>Code Compliance</u>. Licensee's use of the Premises shall at all times be in compliance with all applicable Codes, Regulations, and Rules be they City, County, State, or Federal. This includes but is not limited to the City's Municipal Code.

- C. <u>Modification of City Property</u>. Other than the scope of work as described herein for the fiber installation, the Licensee shall not make any modification to City property without providing the City a formal request that includes proper documentation prior to the alteration of any City. No modifications made be made to City property without prior written consent from the City. Such written consent will require the Licensee to submit a formal proposal for any modifications. The City may require at its sole discretion detailed plans and specifications for modifications. Licensee shall pay for all modifications and alterations. Licensee shall make all modifications required to ensure the functionality of its operations within the Railyard.
- D. <u>Vendor Documentation</u>. Licensee shall provide to the City for review and approval copies of any requested information from vendors providing services to the Licensee on City property including but not limited to the Licensee's Contract with the Vendor, all Supporting Contract Documents, the Certificate of Insurance, Business License, Designs, Details, and Specifications. No modifications made be made to City property without prior review and approval of such documentation and accompanying written consent from the City of Santa Fe's Facilities Division Director or their appointee. The City may require some of these Vendor Documents be included in this License as an Exhibit.
- E. <u>Vendor Oversight</u>. Licensee shall include the City of Santa Fe's Facilities Division Director or their appointee in all phases of any work performed by the Licensee's Vendors on City Property. This includes but is not limited to ensuring such City staff are included in all planning, construction, inspection, and approval meetings.
- F. <u>Acceptance of Work.</u> Licensee shall ensure the City of Santa Fe's Facilities Division Director, or their appointee has inspected and approved any work performed prior to accepting the work as complete. These City representatives may require additional work be performed to ensure the improvements meet City standards.
- G. <u>Warranty Period</u>. The Licensee shall ensure that any improvements made on City property by Licensees' vendor(s) shall be accompanied by a minimum 1-Year Warranty on all materials, parts, and labor. Specifically, the warranty will include the fiber, the conduit, the interface box and the labor as described in Exhibits A and B. The warranty will not cover any damage that may occur after installation, such as breaking the fiber inside the building or by third parties breaking the underground fiber with a backhoe, or some such accident, nor does it include any sort of vandalism or Acts of God, (such as weather) or force majeure. The Licensee shall ensure this warranty is transferable to the City of Santa Fe.
- H. <u>Inspections</u>. All modifications made to City property shall be inspected and approved by the City of Santa Fe's Facilities Division Director or their designee before acceptance of these modifications are approved. If upon inspection any deficiencies, defects, poor workmanship, or any other issues are discovered the Licensee shall insure all corrections and repairs are made prior to the acceptance and completion of the work.
- I. <u>Repairs and Maintenance</u>. Licensee shall not cause or permit any waste, damage, or injury to the Premises or to any improvements made to the Premises. Licensee shall, at its sole expense, maintain the Premises in good and clean condition at all times and shall be responsible for the costs of any and all required repairs, and replacements, that arise during the Term of this License that are a result of Licensee's use of the Premises. Repairs and replacements required to be made by the Licensee shall be made promptly as and when necessary and shall be at least equal in quality of materials and workmanship to that originally existing in the Premises.

6. NO INTEREST CREATED.

Licensee acknowledges that no interest or estate of any kind whatsoever in the Premises is conveyed by this License or by occupancy or use of the Premises pursuant to the License. This License shall not be assigned by Licensee.

7. INSURANCE.

A. Comprehensive General Liability. Licensee, at its own cost and expense shall carry and maintain in full force and effect during the term of this License, comprehensive general liability insurance covering bodily injury, personal and advertising injury, and property damage liability. Such insurance shall be in a form and with an insurance company acceptable to the City with limits of not less than of \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$1,000,000 in the aggregate against claims for which the City could be held liable under the New Mexico Tort Claims Act. Such insurance shall include broad form contractual liability coverage and be endorsed to provide that the City, Santa Fe Conservation Trust, Santa Fe Railyard Community Corporation, and the directors, officials, officers, employees and agents for those entities are named as an additional insured for

Licensee's operations hereunder. City will be notified in writing within ten (10) days of cancellation of such insurance for any reason. Licensee shall furnish the City with a "Certificate of Insurance" and applicable endorsements prior to the City's issuance of this License.

- B. <u>Workers' Compensation Insurance and Employer's Liability Insurance.</u> Workers' Compensation Insurance shall be within statutory limits, and Employer's Liability insurance shall be within limits of not less than \$1,000,000 per accident or disease. The Workers' Compensation policy shall be endorsed with a waiver of subrogation in favor of the City, its directors, officials, officers, employees, and agents.
- C. Provisions Applicable to All Insurance Requirements.
 - (a). <u>Acceptability of Insurers</u>. Unless otherwise reviewed and accepted by the City, all required insurance shall be placed with insurers with a current A.M. Best rating of not less than A- VII and be admitted to do business in the State of New Mexico, or approved by the Surplus Lines Association.
 - (b) <u>Verification of Coverage</u>. Licensee shall furnish the City with certificates of insurance and endorsements effecting coverage required by this Agreement on forms satisfactory to the City. The certificates of insurance shall be signed by a person authorized by that insurer to bind coverage on its behalf. All certificates and endorsements shall be received and approved by the City before Licensee performance under this agreement. Acceptance of Licensee's Certificates of Insurance does not relieve Licensee of the insurance requirements, nor decrease the liability of Licensee under this Agreement. It is Licensee's responsibility to ensure its compliance with these insurance requirements. Any actual or alleged failure on the part of the City to obtain proof of insurance required under this Agreement shall not in any way be construed to be a waiver of any right or remedy for the City, in this or any regard.
 - (c). <u>Primary and Noncontributory</u>. The insurance required to be maintained by Licensee shall be primary and any insurance or self-insurance maintained by the City shall not be required to contribute to it.
 - (d) <u>Umbrella or Excess Insurance</u>. Any Umbrella or Excess insurance shall also apply on a primary and noncontributory basis for the benefit of the City before the City's own primary insurance or self-insurance shall be called upon to protect it as a Named Insured. Such Umbrella or Excess policy(ies) shall be endorsed to include the City, its directors, officials, officers, employees, and agents as additional insureds.
 - (e). <u>Waiver of Subrogation</u>. Licensee shall obtain waiver of subrogation endorsements stating that Licensee and its insurers waive any and all rights of recovery against the City, its directors, officials, officers, employees, and agents.

9. <u>INDEMNIFICATION</u>.

Licensee shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend the City from all losses, damages, claims or judgments, including payments of all attorneys' fees and costs on account of any suit, judgment, execution, claim, action or demand arising out Licensee's use of the Premises, and/or the City's issuance of this License.

10. NEW MEXICO TORT CLAIMS ACT.

Any liability incurred by the City of Santa Fe in connection with this License is subject to the immunities and limitations of the New Mexico Tort Claims Act, Section 41-4-1, et seq. NMSA 1978, as amended. The City and its "public employees" as defined in the New Mexico Tort Claims Act, do not waive sovereign immunity, do not waive any defense, and do not waive any limitation of liability pursuant to law. No provision of this License modifies or waives any provision of the New Mexico Tort Claims Act.



Request for the approval and execution of the License and Transfer Agreement between the International Folk Art Market (IFAM) and the City of Santa Fe for development of fiber optic infrastructure on City property. Tim Farrell, Property Development Manager, tgfarrell@santafenm.gov, 505-490-1659.

BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY:

The International Folk Art Market (IFAM) will be holding their annual market event from July $5^{th} - 9^{th}$ at the Santa Fe Railyard Park and has requested to install a dedicated fiber optic line within the Railyard Park to support WIFI at the event and point of sale systems. With over 1,000 vendors selling their crafts, a high-speed wireless point-of-sale network is required to quickly process the thousands of sales transactions.


We are requesting the approval of a License and Transfer agreement with IFAM. This agreement first allows IFAM to install and utilize an internet fiber connection and wireless network within the Railyard Park to support their point-of-sale system for their annual market (License). Once installed, the ownership of this fiber connection will be passed to the City indefinitely (transfer). The City would then provide IFAM access to this network for their events free of charge. This License and Transfer Agreement includes requirements including, but not limited to:

- Provision of \$1,000,000 in insurance coverage.
- Indemnification of the City.
- City review and approval of all modifications made.
- Requirement to comply with all rules, regulations, and codes.
- City inspection and acceptance of any work completed.
- A one-year warranty period.

IFAM has contracted with CyberMesa who has provided a design for the installation of the new line. The new branch fiber line would run from the existing main line along the rail corridor, terminating at the City Maintenance Shed and Community Room building, which is located south of Site Santa Fe. See the diagram below. A secure router/modem will be located on the interior wall of the shed's east meeting room. Larry Worstell, Infrastructure Service Manager for City ITT, has reviewed and approved the specifications of this installation and system, and

Facilities has reviewed and will supervise and inspect the boring and equipment being mounted in the shed.

In lieu of a fee for this accommodation to IFAM, after the installation and the City's inspection of the system, IFAM will transfer, and the City will accept ownership of the fiber, modem and router. The City, should they choose, will have the option after the IFAM event to provide to the public low bandwidth WiFi within the Railyard Park on a full or part time basis for events and gatherings throughout the year. There is a provision within the License Agreement for IFAM to have use of the fiber at no charge from the City during any future IFAM event at the Railyard.
