Request for Approval of License and Advertising Agreement with Kiwanis Club of Santa Fe, Inc. in the Total Amount of \$275,000 Over Five Year Term for the Use of City of Santa Fe's Trademarked Tourism-Related Logo(s) for the Purpose of Advertising Santa Fe; Department Contact: Randy Randall, TSF Executive Director, <u>trandall@santafenm.gov</u>, 505-955-6209.

BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY:

The governing body approved a \$1,733,593 budget addition to the TOURISM Santa Fe FY24 budget on December 13, 2023, using a combination of excess lodger's tax budgeted and support from lodger's tax fund balances. This included an addition to advertising in the amount of \$125,000 to advertise on a Zozobra special shape balloon being created to celebrate the 100th burning of Zozobra on August 31, 2024. This advertising use was subject to development and governing body approval of the contract with Kiwanis that would avoid any liability on the part of the city in the ongoing flying of the balloon. The contract itself is an advertising contract for five years of advertising on the balloon in the amount of \$275,000 with \$125,000 being allocated in FY24, \$45,000 in FY25 and \$35,000 each in FY's 26, 27 and 28. It also provides for a first option on continued advertising in the same location after the expiration of this initial contract. Santa Fe will be displayed on the front of the balloon is a space that is 19.5 feet tall and 37 feet wide on the lower part of the balloon. To put this into perspective, the total balloon from the basket to the top of the upraised balloon is 130 feet. The actual image of the balloon is not available at this time as it will be released by a joint press conference by Mayor Weber and Mayor Keller of Albuquerque scheduled for May 20, 2024 at Balloon Fiesta Park in Albuquerque. The first public inflation of the balloon will occur on the morning of August 31at Mager's Field in advance of the evening burning of Zozobra.

The planned schedule of appearances for the balloon is being finalized and will include a total of 8 events including the Albuquerque Balloon Festival and the Red Rock Balloon Rally in Gallup

with consideration being given to two balloon festivals in Texas, two in Colorado, two in Arizona and at least one in Southern California. The specific festival list will be finalized once Kiwanis has the pilot identified. These are our strongest regional markets, each with major festivals and large attendance bring maximum exposure for Santa Fe.

CITY OF SANTA FE LICENSE AND ADVERTISING AGREEMENT

This License and Advertising Agreement is made and entered into by the City of Santa Fe, New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as "Licensor," and **Kiwanis Club of Santa Fe, Inc., a New Mexico Non-Profit Organization**, hereinafter referred to as "Licensee" (collectively the "Parties") and is effective as set forth below.

THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

1. GRANT OF RIGHTS

- A. Licensor hereby grants to Licensee the right and license to utilize the City of Santa Fe's trademarked tourism-related logo(s) (collectively: Logo) for the purpose of advertising on a special-shape Zozobra hot air balloon (Balloon) to increase public awareness of the City of Santa Fe's tourism destination Brand.
- B. Usage of the Logo pursuant to this Agreement is strictly limited to advertising on the Balloon in accordance with the creative design approved by Licensor.
- C. Any rights not expressly granted herein are reserved to Licensor.

2. WARRANTIES AND REPRESENTATIONS

- A. Licensor and Licensee each warrant that it has the right to enter into and fully perform this Agreement.
- B. Licensee warrants and represents that:
 - i. Logo will be displayed on the front and bottom of Balloon.
 - ii. Logo located on the front of Balloon will be at least thirty-five (35) feet wide and nineteen (19) feet tall.
 - iii. Beginning July 1, 2024, Balloon will be used to participate and perform at least one inflation that is visible to the public in a minimum of six (6) balloon rallies or festivals per fiscal year, one of which must be the Albuquerque International Balloon Fiesta. Licensor may request any writer, influencer, or media or governmental representative to fly as a passenger in Balloon at each event. Licensee must submit to Licensor, within thirty (30) days of the conclusion of each event, a written summary Proof of Performance (see Exhibit A). Licensee or its contractor may participate in ballon rallies or festival prior to July 1, 2024, if the Balloon is manufactured and available for flight.
 - iv. Balloon will be fully insured by Licensee or Licensee's contractor during the term of this Agreement to include liability insurance, as defined in Article 7 (INDEMNITY AND INSURANCE), for bodily injury or death, and the replacement or repair costs of the Balloon in the event of theft or damage. If such theft or damage occurs, and Licensee does not replace or repair the Balloon, the Licensor will be refunded the prorated amount paid at the time of theft or damage according to section 3 below. No more money will be paid by Licensor to

Licensee until Balloon is replaced or repaired and Licensee is able to fulfill its commitments.

- v. Balloon will not be used for any activity in violation of any federal, state, or local laws;
- vi. Licensee will not assert trademark rights in the Logo, or elements or variants thereof. Furthermore, Licensee will not interfere with Licensor's rights in the Logo, including challenging Licensor's use, registration of, or application to register the Logo, alone or in combination with other words or designs, anywhere in the world. Licensee is further prohibited from attempting to register the Logo, or any confusing similar mark, whether or not registered by Licensor, alone or in combination with other words or designs, as a U.S. or foreign trademark, and from asserting trademark rights into such Logo through the Licensee's use.
- vii. Licensee, or its contractor acting on behalf of Licensee, will provide all individuals who enter and/or ride in the Balloon with a form that they are required to sign before participation in any Balloon activities. The form will confirm that the passengers will: a) understand that the Balloon activities are dangerous and involve a risk of injury or death, or damage to personal property; b) assume full responsibility for all risks involved with their participation in Balloon activities; c) certify that they have no known physical or mental defects or conditions that prevent them from any participation in Balloon activities; d) certify that they are 18 years of age or older, or that they are the legal guardian(s) and/or parent(s) of minor passengers; e) agree to follow the instructions of the pilot in connections with the Balloon's activities; and f) agree to indemnify and defend Licensee and its contractor from any and all claims rights, liabilities, demands, or causes of action known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, arising out of the Balloon activities for any passengers, their heirs, successors, assigns, co-participants, rescuers, or others in connection with the Balloon activities, including those arising from the inherent risks of hot air ballooning activities, any negligence of Licensee and its contractor, or any dangerous activities of any properties upon which the Balloon activities take place.
- viii. Licensee shall not alter Logo in any way without prior written consent from the Licensor's Director of Tourism or their appointee.
- C. Licensor warrants and represents that:
 - i. Licensor has all rights and consents necessary to grant this license for the intended purpose hereunder.
 - ii. Licensor controls one hundred percent (100%) of the copyright and trademark rights of the Logo, including renewals.
 - iii. This Agreement does not and will not infringe upon the copyright or any other rights of any third party.
 - iv. Licensor does not hold ownership of or any title to the Balloon.

3. COMPENSATION FOR ADVERTISING

Licensor agrees to pay Licensee advertising and promotion fee in the amount of One Hundred Twenty Five Thousand dollars and zero cents (\$125,000.00) in FY24. Forty-Five Thousand dollars and zero cents (\$45,000.00) in FY25, Thirty-Five Thousand dollars and zero cents (\$35,000.00) in FY26, and Thirty-Five Thousand dollars and zero cents (\$35,000.00) in FY27, and Thirty-Five Thousand dollars and zero cents (\$35,000.00) in FY28, for a total compensation of Two Hundred and Seventy-Five Thousand dollars and zero cents (\$275,000.00) over five (5) years.

4. TERM

This Agreement shall become effective upon its execution by both Parties and shall terminate on **June 30**, **2028**. unless terminated pursuant to Article 5 (Termination). Licensor shall have the right of first refusal for any subsequent advertising on Balloon. The Parties agree that the price per year for a future License and Advertising Agreement for this same Balloon and Logo would be 1/3 (one third) of the average annual operating costs of the Balloon for the last three years of this Agreement.

5. TERMINATION

The Parties may only terminate this Agreement for cause, appropriations, or if a Party becomes unable to perform the services contracted for. The terms of this Agreement are contingent upon sufficient appropriations and authorization being made by the governing body of the City of Santa Fe for the performance of this Agreement. If sufficient appropriations and authorization are not made by the governing body City of Santa Fe, this Agreement shall terminate upon written notice being given by the Licensor to Licensee. The Licensor's decision as to whether sufficient appropriations are available shall be reasonable and will be accepted by the Licensee as final. If this Agreement is terminated pursuant to this Article, the terminating Party shall provide the other Party written notice of termination at least thirty (30) days prior to the effective date of the termination.

6. TERMINATION MANAGEMENT

Immediately upon receipt by either the Licensor or Licensee of notice of termination of this Agreement, the Licensee shall take such action as the Licensor will direct for the protection, preservation, retention, or transfer of all property titled to the Licensor, including activities, related intellectual property of the Licensor, and records generated under this Agreement.

7. INDEMNITY AND INSURANCE

A. The Licensee or its contractor shall indemnify and defend the Licensor, the City of Santa Fe, and its employees from all actions, proceedings, claims, demands, costs, damages, attorney's fees and all other liabilities and expenses of any kind from any source which may arise out of the performance of this Agreement, caused by negligent act or failure to act of Licensee, its officers, employees, contractors, subcontractors or agents, during the time when Licensee, its officer, agent, employee, contractor, or subcontractor thereof has or is using the Logo pursuant to this Agreement. Neither Party shall be liable for any damages beyond its control including, but not limited to Acts of God, or any other cause beyond the reasonable control of the Party whose performance is affected.

B. The Licensee or its contractor shall maintain for the duration of the Agreement hot air balloon insurance with limits of no less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence for bodily injury, personal injury, death, and property damage liability combined. The policy shall include coverage for all liabilities related to the Balloon. and the operation and flight of the Balloon. The insurance shall apply separately to each insured against whom the claim is made, or suit is brought, subject to the Licensee's limit of liability. The policy must include the City of Santa Fe, its officers, agents, and employees as additional insureds, but only insofar as the operations under this Agreement are concerned.

8. QUALITY CONTROL

Licensor shall have the right, at all reasonable times, to inspect the Balloon and any associated promotional activities employing the Logo to ensure that such use is of proper quality and otherwise consistent with this Agreement, and Licensor may terminate the License should it determine that the use is inconsistent with this Agreement.

9. ENFORCEMENT OF AGREEMENT

A Party's failure to require strict performance of any provision of this Agreement shall not waive or diminish that Party's right thereafter to demand strict compliance with that or any other provision. No waiver by a Party of any of its rights under this Agreement shall be effective unless express and in writing, and no effective waiver by a Party of any of its rights shall be effective to waive any other rights.

10. STATUS OF LICENSEE

Licensee, its agents, and employees are independent contractors performing services for the Licensor and are not employees of the City of Santa Fe.

11. APPLICABLE LAW

The laws of the State of New Mexico shall govern this Agreement, without giving effect to its choice of law provisions. Venue shall be proper only in a New Mexico court of competent jurisdiction in accordance with NMSA 1978, § 38-3-1 (G). By execution of this Agreement, Licensee acknowledges and agrees to the jurisdiction of the courts of the State of New Mexico over any and all lawsuits arising under or out of any term of this Agreement.

12. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement incorporates all the agreements, covenants and understandings between the Parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into this written Agreement. No prior agreement or understanding, oral or otherwise, of the Parties or their agents shall be valid or enforceable unless embodied in this Agreement.

13. AMENDMENT

This Agreement shall not be altered, changed or amended except by instrument in writing executed by the Parties hereto and all other required signatories.

14. NOTICES

Any notice required to be given to either Party by this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be delivered in person, by courier service or by electronic or U.S. mail, either first class or certified, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, as follows:
