# BUCKMAN DIRECT DIVERSION BDDB SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH B&D INDUSTRIES, INC

THIS SERVICES AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made and entered into by and between the Buckman Direct Diversion Board ("BDDB") and B&D Industries, Inc. ("Contractor"). The effective date of this Agreement shall be the date when it is executed by the BDDB.

## 1. SCOPE OF SERVICES

Contractor shall provide services for the BDDB described as follows:

Provide on-call miscellaneous HVAC and Plumbing services as described in Price Agreement Number 30-0000-23-00084 as accepted for State of New Mexico agencies and local public bodies.

# 2. STANDARD OF PERFORMANCE; LICENSES

- A. Contractor represents that Contractor possesses the personnel, experience and knowledge necessary to perform the Scope of Services described in this Agreement. Contractor shall perform its services in accordance with generally accepted standards and practices customarily utilized by competent consulting firms in effect at the time Contractor's services are rendered.
- B. Contractor agrees to obtain and maintain throughout the term of this Agreement, all applicable professional and business licenses required by law, for itself, its employees, agents, representatives and subcontractors.

## 3. COMPENSATION

Compensation under this Agreement shall be in an amount not to exceed one hundred twenty dollars (\$120,000.00) plus applicable gross receipts tax, at the rates and charges contained in the attached Exhibit A.

#### 12. INSURANCE

- D. Cancellation. B. Detailed records that indicate the date, time and nature of services rendered shall also be retained for a period of three years after the term of this agreement expires. These records shall be subject to inspection by City of Santa Fe, the Department of Finance and Administration, the State Auditor. The BDDB and the City of Santa Fe shall have the right to audit the billing both before and after payment to Contractor. Payment under this Agreement shall not foreclose the right of the BDDB or City of Santa Fe to recover excessive or illegal payments.

# 17. APPLICABLE LAW; CHOICE OF LAW; VENUE

Contractor shall abide by all applicable federal and state laws and regulations, and all ordinances, rules and regulations of the BDDB. In any action, suit or legal dispute arising from this Agreement, Contractor agrees that the laws of the State of New Mexico shall govern. Any action or suit commenced in the courts of the State of New Mexico shall be brought in the First Judicial District Court.

#### 18. AMENDMENT

This Agreement shall not be altered, changed or modified except by an amendment in writing executed by the parties hereto.

# 19. SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the services to be performed hereunder, and all such agreements, covenants and understandings have been merged into this Agreement. This Agreement expresses the entire

Agreement and understanding between the parties with respect to said services. No prior agreement

or understanding, verbal or otherwise, of the parties or their agents shall be valid or enforceable unless

embodied in this Agreement.

20. NON-DISCRIMINATION

During the term of this Agreement, Contractor shall not discriminate against any employee

or applicant for an employment position to be used in the performance of services by Contractor

hereunder, on the basis of ethnicity, race, age, religion, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, sex,

In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this Agreement or any application

thereof shall be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, the validity, legality, and

enforceability of the remaining provisions contained herein, and any other application thereof shall

not in any way be affected or impaired thereby.
