If Property Owner chooses to split samples, Property Owner is responsible for the provision of all equipment and accessories and for laboratory costs necessary to split the samples. Installations on the Property will be placed to minimize interference with the movement of vehicles and regular activities on the Property. Following completion of the project, INTERA and/or its subcontractors will properly abandon all wells, remove equipment, all materials, trash, fencing, and other associated items and return the Property as close as possible to the pre-entrance condition.

This permission is given voluntarily with knowledge of the right to refuse and without coercion. We have had an opportunity to ask questions and all questions have been answered to our satisfaction. Any liability incurred by the City of Santa Fe in connection with this Agreement is subject to the immunities and limitations of the New Mexico Tort Claims Act, Section 41-4-1, et. seq. NMSA 1978, as amended.

Subject: Consent for Access to Property Agreement by INTERA to drill monitoring wells on

City owned land

Hi John, the attached "Consent for Access to Property" agreement from INTERA which authorizes them to drill monitoring wells on lands of the City of Santa Fe and is being routed to you for signature. This endeavor to drill monitoring wells on City land is tied to monitoring of a site owned by PNM (which adjoins the Potencia Street Well site) and had a power generating plant thereon previously which has PCB contamination and for years the City has allowed drilling companies to drill monitoring wells on adjoining lands owned by the City in order to confirm the movement of contamination from the site. This latest agreement will allow for INTERA to drill three additional wells on City owned land as shown on the exhibit which are in close proximity to the PNM parcel. Costs will be covered by others and traffic control measures will be performed while the work is being done. I am assisting the Water dept with getting the agreement executed by City officials and it is already approved as to form by the City Attorneys Office.
