ACTION:

Request for Approval of a Grant Agreement with the Department of Transportation Federal Transit Administration (FTA) for Section 5339 Funding for Public Transportation Capital Funding in the Total Amount of \$166,924. (Gabrielle Chavez, Transit Director of Administration; gnchavez@santafenm.gov)

1. Request for Approval of a Budget Amendment Resolution (BAR) in the Total Amount of \$205,337 with \$166,924 from the FTA Grant and \$38,413 Matching Funds From the Transit Fund Balance to FY25 Transit Grant Revenue, WIP Design, and Vehicles > 1.5.

BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY:

The City of Santa Fe's Transit Division was awarded \$166,924 in Section 5339 Urbanized Area Capital Funding from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA), distributed through the New Mexico Department of Transportation. This funding allocation is determined by a formula that considers the Urbanized Area's population, population density, and service levels. The funds were designated for two purposes: partial reimbursement for the purchase of a cutaway bus and partial reimbursement for engineering consultant services to evaluate bus stop compliance.

<u>Award Executive Summary:</u> This grant application represents the FY2021 apportionment of Small Urban Section 5339 in the amount of \$166,924 to the City of Santa Fe. The Governor's Apportionment split letter from NMDOT is attached in Application Details. This award will fund two projects.

Project 1:

A portion of these funds will be used to share the purchase cost of one Santa Fe Pickup replacement 14 passenger cutaway bus. The total cost of the bus will be \$225,342, of which \$146,402 of the cost will be reimbursed with grant NM-2020-025. The remaining shared cost of \$45,139 is requested for this grant application. The local match funds will be provided by the City of Santa Fe through its 1/4 cent gross receipts tax dedicated to transit. The replacement vehicle will have a useful life of 8 years/240,000 miles and will replace Unit 801, VIN 1N9MNA8G28C084195, a 2008 Eldorado Easy Rider II that has met it's useful life of 14 years.

Project 2:

The remainder of the apportioned amount of this grant funding application in the amount of \$121,786 representing 80% federal share. The local match is 20% or \$30,447. SFTs share (local match) will be provided by the City of Santa Fe, through its -cent gross receipt tax dedicated to transit. The total project is \$152,233.

The purpose of this project award will be to bring existing bus stops/shelters into ADA compliance. This will be accomplished by repairing or replacing any deficiency in the access (sidewalk) to the bus stop/shelter, the shelter's structure or its signage. Deficiencies and prioritization of our 433 bus stops has been documented, indexed and analyzed in the 2016 Santa Fe Metropolitan Bus Stop and Sidewalk Connectivity Assessment final report and will be used extensively in the execution of this project. The report is uploaded.

The activities to be performed will be the repairing or replacing: shelter panels, shelter roofs, signage, sidewalks and amenities for 9 of 20 bus shelters. List of 20 bus shelters is uploaded. Shelter foundations may require repaying or concrete work. In a few

instances a slight extension will be added to accommodate a wheelchair. All proposed activities will occur within the existing easement/right of way. The bus stops to be replaced are metal on contract slabs. We estimate that the unit cost of the replacement shelters at \$17,236.21. The useful life of the replacement shelter is 20 years. We anticipate that this award will fund improvements to 9 shelters.

The expected outcomes will be to provide greater safety, access and comfort to all transit users. This will result in an increase of ridership and is expected to lessen the demand for our paratransit services. The renovated bus shelters will improve the esthetics of the area by providing a pleasing and fresh look to the area. In additional the improved lighting will decrease the opportunities for vandalism to our shelters and the surrounding area.

The intended beneficiaries are pedestrians, bicyclists and transit users within the SFT service area. All improvements will be located within the mile catchment area of bus stations/stops, making them eligible for FTA Capital Funding and will be done within the existing footprint of the shelter area.

Activities to be performed:

Procure a replacement cutaway CNG bus for the Santa Fe Pick-up Shuttle and make bus stop/shelter improvements.

Expected outcomes:

Provide safe and efficient service to the Santa Fe Pick-up shuttle as Santa Fe Trails continues to reimplement service, previously modified due to the Covid-19 pandemic and improve bus station/stops around the city.

Intended beneficiaries:

Visitors and residents of the City of Santa Fe.

Subrecipient Activities: None.

Research and Development: This award does not include research and development activities.

Indirect Costs: This award does not include an indirect cost rate.
